Thank you for purchasing one of the new Micro Innovations ADAMnet Floppy Disk Drives. We have done our best to ensure the unit you have purchased is of the highest quality available. The ADAMnet drive consists of a disk drive enclosure, a DC Power cube, a telephone cable, and a diskette. Please verify that all components are present and that none have been damaged in shipment. If something is missing or damaged, please inform your dealer immediately.

Since the drive is completely compatible with the Coleco unit it replaces, the instructions for its use are very simple. The following steps will guide you through the installation process:

- Set the drive address (the toggle switch) on the back panel to the correct drive number for your system (1 for the first drive, 2 for the second),
- Plug the modular cable into the "ADAMnet Input" jack on the disk drive and into your ADAM computer (the left side modular connector),
- Plug your second ADAM floppy disk drive (if you have one) into the "ADAMnet Output" jack,
- Plug the DC power cube into the back of the Micro Innovations ADAMnet disk drive (it only goes in one way) and into an AC power outlet, and
- Turn on all of the components.
- Insert your boot disk (or none, if you want to use SmartWriter), pull the "RESET" switch on the console, and the computer will boot your software off of diskette.

To use the ADAMnet drive, just remember that its device number is d5 (disk drive #1) or d6 (disk drive #2) in SmartBASIC. Most EOS application programs will automatically detect the drive's presence and will give you the option to read from it or write to it when you use the "GET/STORE" function. It will show up as Drive #1 or Drive #2, depending on how you have the address switch set.

We've supplied you with a diskette that contains AJM Software's File Manager, version 2.2. This program is NOT a public domain offerring. We pay AJM a royalty fee on each disk drive we deliver. You are free to copy the program for your own use. However, PLEASE **DO NOT** give copies of this program to others. If AJM learns of unauthorized copies of this program, they will disallow us from distributing it with our drive. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated!

The File Manager program offers many valuable features that you will need to format, copy, and edit diskettes. To start it, just insert the diskette and pull the RESET switch. The menus should lead you through its operation with a minimum of problems. Please call your dealer if you have any questions concerning its operation.

We also have many public domain programs available on the Micro Innovations Bulletin Board System that you may find of interest, including the current versions of the TDOS operating system. There is a floppy only version that you can use with the ADAMnet floppy disk drive. The MI BBS is on-line between 6:30 PM and 6:30 AM every weekday night, and 24 hours a day on weekends. Please do not call the BBS during the normal 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM hours, Monday through Fridays. This line is used for other business purposes during those hours.

If you experience any problems with your ADAMnet drive, please first check with the dealer you purchased it from. If he or she cannot assist you, then feel free to give us a call. Our technical support hours are 6:30 PM through 9:30 PM, Monday through Friday. If you call at other times, you can leave a message on our answering machine. We also have a Fax machine connected to the voice line. So if you'd like to send us a Fax, that is also an alternative.
