Software Loading Instructions

This booklet contains the information you need to load programs from the four ADAM HOME SOFTWARE LIBRARY digital data packs. Choose a digital data pack—APPLICATIONS, EDUCATIONAL, MATHEMATICS AND MISCELLANY or GAMES AND GRAPHICS—and use the following step-by-step instructions to run the program of your choice!

Pick a Pack of Particular Programs!

Each data pack is a volume of specific types of programs. Choose any volume and get an array of related programs!

Get a degree of ADAM smarts from the educational data pack:

Ten Steps for 32 Programs!

Step 1: Review the ADAM Set-Up Manual for instructions on how to power up the computer and insert a digital data pack.

Step 2: Make sure that no diskettes or data packs are in any of the drives.

Step 3: Turn the switch on the back of the ADAM printer to **ON**. Turn the television on.

Step 4: SmartBasic[™] needs to be loaded into your ADAM[™] before you run any of your ADAM HOME SOFT-WARE LIBRARY programs.

Insert the SmartBasic[™] digital data pack into the drive. Press Computer Reset on the ADAM Memory Console to start the load.

Step 5: Once SmartBasic™ is loaded and the SmartBasic™ prompt appears, remove your SmartBasic™ data pack. Insert the ADAM HOME SOFTWARE LIBRARY digital data pack that you want into the same drive.

Step 6: Maybe you already know the name of the program you want. Say you wanted to run the Walloons program. Just type **run walloons** and press RETURN. Your program loads and you are ready to go.

Step 7: Otherwise, to see the contents of whichever of the four ADAM HOME SOFTWARE LIBRARY data packs you have chosen, type run menu. Press RETURN when you finish typing.

Step 8: After a few seconds, the title screen of the specific digital data pack, with further instructions, appears. To get the digital data pack's table of contents, press any key. For example, if you loaded the Graphics and Games Programs digital data pack, you should get ten titles

If, instead, you want to escape from the program and return to the Smart-Basic™, press the ESCAPE key.

Step 9: Read through the list of program names to find the one you want. Walloons? Sparkle? Now, type in the number that corresponds to the program you want and press RETURN.

Step 10: Back to BASIC? If you want to leave a program to return to Smart-Basic™, first, simultaneously press Control and C keys, then press RETURN.

90-Day Limited Warranty

If Customer Service advises you to return your digital data pack, please return it postage prepaid and insured, with your name, address, proof of the date of purchase, and a brief description of the problem to the Service Station you have been directed to return it to by the toll-free service information. If your digital data pack is found to be factory defective during the first 90 days, it will be repaired or replaced at no cost to you. If the digital data pack is found to have been consumer damaged or abused and therefore not covered by the warranty, then you will be advised, in advance, of repair costs.
