Effective with release #2 of Victory Software's two newest titles, FIRE ANT and ZETA-7, each program is shipped with a dongle, a little electronic device that plugs into a joystick port. The program must see it before it runs. Although disk copies can be made, without the dongle they won't run. It's not absolutely foolproof, but very difficult to defeat. For the price of the game it really is not worth it to most people. We expect it will make a noticeable improvement in both your sales and ours!

DO YOU WANT TO CONTINUE to receive Dealer's Download? Our mailing list has grown into the thousands and for economy's sake we find a purge is necessary.
