Seems as though each month, all I do is gripe, in this column. Well, this month is no different. We have had a lot of trouble with distributors, last month, and this one too.

They advertise certain items, and when called, they will tell you they have it in stock. We order most everything pre-paid, by Certified Check or money order, to expedite matters. Well, four different distributors did it to us in the last 60 days.

One even went so far as to send us inferior, much lower priced items, charging the same price as the items we ordered, then saying we would have to pay the return shipping! This was on Combination RGB, Separated and Composite video monitors. Instead of shipping what was ordered, they shipped a far cheaper, composite only monitor. I have a feeling that we will be lucky if we get our money back without a fight.

Circumstances such as these cause us problems, beyond our control, and naturally have a tendency to irk our member customers. We wound up with a source for the monitors we advertise, but all the horsing around, and paying double shipping, plus a higher original price has left us in a rather profitless situation, to say the least. We lost more than the total sales.

So, any of you out there who were experiencing a delay in getting your monitors of one particular model, place yourselves in our shoes. If you had ordered, you would have found yourselves in the same predicament, only individually you would not have had such a large amount of cash involved.

I personally flew to one of these jewels of merchandising who had a large chunk of the Group's money, and found that they had not had any of that particular item in stock, and that none were available from the factory, WHEN THEY ACCEPTED OUR ORDER!

Another problem arose, when our cabinet manufacturer, who makes most of the cabinets for the smaller to medium size computer devices we produce went out of business, without any warning. Just try to get a plastics manufacturer to make cabinets different from his usual line, without putting up a \$100,000 (at least) letter of credit!

This also applies to circuit boards. I just completed an arrangement to have two different manufacturers make our new boards. Several types will be made. Tried six companies before mutual satisfaction was achieved. We located a source for a new board coating, which will virtually eliminate the copying of boards. It is a liquid polycarbonate, glass filled. Our finished boards will be dipped in the liquid, and dried several times. The result is a heavy coating similar to some watch cases. Once hardened, it is impervious to solvents, etc., and any attempts to remove it destroys the components too. "BYE, PIRATES!"

Lots more news when I return from this trip.

Well, here we are again. We thought that we had the ultimate in screen improvement with the ARE-1, which does an excellent job. Then, we found ways of improving even this.

The new model has another control, improved circuitry, with considerably greater ability to boost, cut, and clarify the signal emitted by ADAM and displayed on the screen.

As known by most, the resolution with ADAM, especially on a TV (but to a lesser degree, on a Monitor) is often accompanied by a white blur, a shadow, a smear, around text and graphics. Colors are not sharp and clear. (Even if you think they are, the use of our Resolution Enhancer almost always gives a large improvement. We say "almost always" for the simple reason that we have no control over the particular ADAM or the particular viewing device you have. It is possible that they are doing the best they can. On most TVs, for example, the resolution varies considerably from center screen to the edge, and from top to bottom. Colors have quite a tendency to bleed into each other. This problem was analyzed by us. We discovered what was necessary to improve or correct it to the optimum for most equipment, and came up with our first production model, the ARE-1. It has been well received, and will cure the ills for quite a lot of ADAM users.

There was a number of situations where the ARE-1 simply was not sufficiently powerful to overcome the approximately 30% of stubborn cases. Back to the drawing board!

We increased power, increased ability to screen unwanted signals, and introduced a continuously variable control system. The result was a definite upgrade. Next, placed the works in a new cabinet, considerably nicer than the previous model.

The use of this device will definitely make your text and graphics as good as the combination of your ADAM, your cables, and your TV and Monitor can do. Remember, any chain is only as strong as its weakest link. If you have an extremely poor TV, or a poor Monitor, do not expect much improvement, sometimes none is possible. But in the majority of cases the text and graphics show a tremendous improvement. You will never know if you do not own one.

We made it easy to install. Just remove the ADAM cable from your viewing device, plug this cable into the ARE, use the supplied Gold End cable to go from the ARE to the viewing device. Insert the AC plug from the ARE into the source of AC (mains outlet, wall socket, extension or whatever), then follow tuning instructions.

You will now have the best picture possible without major equipment changes. In the majority of cases, you now would simply not want to be without it.

Smile! Aren't you happier now?

===== COMPATIBILITY =====

(Written nearly a year ago, rewritten for the present day ADAM user.)
The problem of compatibility is understood by few, talked about by many. It is undoubtedly the greatest problem faced by designers of peripherals, interfaces, and of course, programmers.

The handwriting is on the wall, so to speak, for ADAM. I doubt seriously if there will be a single major third party producer of software for ADAM'S form of BASIC in existence a year from now. (Prediction came true, early)

We receive many letters asking if items produced, or in R&D by us "Will be compatible with Smart WRITER, etc." We have given this a great deal of consideration, and at this point, are faced with accepting the inevitable conclusion, drawn from two certain elements, that another system of operation is necessary for ADAM.

Firstly, the SmartWRITER system is flawed. Each revision I have seen from 59 to 80, has flaws. Some were corrected in revisions, while adding others.

It makes no sense at all to continue trying to support a flawed operating system or program. Let's not go backward, but forward! ADAM is a very good little computer, as are quite a few Z80 based boxes. COLECO themselves very quickly started abandoning the ADAM, when problems became of overwhelming proportions. Why should we hammer our heads against the wall to support an old, flawed system?

Secondly, BASIC as used by ADAM, is an individual language, tailored just for ADAM alone, thereby limiting what we can do with it, to a considerable extent.

The answer? It is altogether too easy. Use an operating system which is understood by hundreds of peripherals, and many, many thousands of programs, many of which are among the finest to be obtained! The name? CP/M!

I think a reasonable estimate of the presently available programs for CP/M to be above 20,000. Can you show me a thousand, for ADAM? A lot less than that exist. Very few good ones.

We will soon have an excellent CP/M DOS ready, which will equal or better anything on the market. Also LOGOIMP, DATABASE MANAGER, and C language for ADAM. These are just for starters DON'T WRITE ABOUT THESE, JUST READ THE ADAMLAND NEWS!

Have you wondered why there are no readily available 80 column cards for ADAM? Perhaps the most important reason is that the only output on the entry level ADAM is a composite signal, with all information, mixed, in one output signal. The resultant resolution is 262 X 192 pixels, or less. This is far from high resolution. Most people in the industry rate resolution on approximate scales, with 0 to perhaps 250 being low resolution, 250 to 350 medium, 350 to 600, high, and anything above 600, very high resolution.

For example, the IBM high resolution on PC-AT is 600 X 200, while most DHR boards alter this to 600 X 400. or higher.

Now for sake of illustration, let's assume that you have a black marking pen, and drawing on white paper, you execute a 2 inch high letter A, in bold print. Now let us assume that you take a 1/4 paper punch, and punch a determinate amount of holes in each part of the letter, in measured, regular fashion, but with the letter still readable.

Next step, transfer the same holes to another piece of paper, draw a letter A just a little less than half the original 2 inch on a piece of something transparent, and hold it under the hole pattern. It becomes far less readable, almost unrecognizable! This is what happens when you attempt changing ADAM's 36 character display to an 80 character display on the same screen. Holes, gaps, pixels remain the original size, but the characters are smaller, so they are less readable.

The holes represented the spaces around the pixels on a color screen, but a similar analogy may be drawn for a monochrome screen, although the mono will give the appearance of better resolution, any time.

An "80 column card" by itself, merely displays output in 80 columns, but decreases the readability, rather than improving it. We manufacture two devices intended only to improve the readability of any screen, any system using composite output. It of course, does not operate on RGB.

One way around this, although not a true solution, is to use a monitor with a smaller "dot pitch", which means less space between the picture elements. This automatically makes the resolved image better. This is why we stress the use of a monitor, such as the TEKNIKA MJ22, a big improvement. To do it best, combine the 80 column card with a "High Resolution" card for maximum effect. While doing this, it is even more productive to use a "DOUBLE High Resolution" card, thereby achieving the greatest possible readability.

These pieces of hardware become too cumbersome to place inside the memory console of ADAM, as is the 512K RAM upgrade.

Next step, RGB. Individual RED-GREEN-BLUE output, instead of composite signal. Here again is a major improvement, but the space needed calls for an outside console, so why not combine the works? 80 col.-DHR-512K RAM and RGB A cable to the memory console is required and slots on the new console for audio, RGB to monitor, plus future expansion slot. All this becomes very expensive, and it is questionable as to whether enough ADAM owners would be interested (they are always interested) enough to actually PURCHASE such a unit.

Jumping into production on such an item, considering the costs to do so, has forced other producers of similar items into bankruptcy.CONT'D

We receive a great number of letters, hundreds per month, asking questions relative to the above, with other questions which reflect that, a large percentage of the enthusiasts out there in ADAMLAND have little realization of what is involved in fulfilling their desires increasing the ability of ADAM, from R&D time, to Production, to Sales, dollarwise. We understand that many of you are eager for upgrades, so let us whet your appetites, on one of our desks is one ADAM with the following features:

If you really would like some of these upgrades, write and tell us, giving us an idea of what you would realistically pay, and we will see what we can do. OK?

As mentioned before, back copies of The ADAMLAND News are being reconstructed. This was made necessary by an unfortunate accident, the leaving of a magnetized tool in a disk cabinet. We will let you know when they are ready.

Among the functions we perform is the one of answering questions posed by both members and non-members.

It seems harsh, but we are going to stop answering these, unless they have a SASE, as indicated on the front page of the newsletter. We simply cannot use the Group's meager funds to support other peoples postage and mailing.

Q. Why do I need a large memory for my ADAM? I think 80K is enough, and adding 64K should surely be plenty.

A. Among the many advantages is the ability to do large scale graphics, enter large programs, do serious word processing, multi-tasking such as printing part of a spreadsheet while working on another part, etc.. It is also quite common that the closer you come to using up your available memory, the slower the operations become.

In addition if you want to use programs with icons, a mouse or light pen, do design work, paint etc., on more than an introductory scale, much more memory is required. Remember, you must have adequate work space left, after your program is loaded. Some of these programs require far more available RAM than ADAM can furnish, some requiring, some occupying, from 128K to 512+ If your enjoyment lies in stuffing those handy little game cartridges into ADAM, and drooling all over yourself as you furiously crank the joystick, forget it Jack!. In all seriousness, we try to make the ADAM the computer it can be, not a toy.

Q. What does compatibility mean?

A. The general interpretation is that of supporting, or capable of working or using-mating one device or program with another. It seems that manufacturers all go their separate way with "standard" outlets, interfaces to connect, cables to connect and programs which may or not work on another manufacturers device, usually not

Q. Will a Xr500 Catastrophe drive work with my ADAM?

A. Sure. If you use it as a paper weight to hold printed information on your desk. Really, now. How the sad snort would we know? This is of course, just a representative question, typical of some we get. PLEASE give us as much information as you possibly can, so we may make at least a try at an intelligent answer. We DO know some things about other equipment, but there is no way we should be expected to equal the ORACLE AT DELPHI.

Q. My ADAM quite often sends a different format to disk than what I have on the screen, most commonly moving paragraphs together, or backing up one line to the last row of characters. Can you help?

A. Welcome to the Club! You are experiencing the deadly ADAM "bump" which we all have to fight. The defect is in the program itself. It is most common when you have made any alterations in your written information, even that which has nothing to do with the bump, in another section, perhaps, of your work. You can do little, if anything to prevent it, however, it usually occurs at the beginning of paragraphs, and spacing between lines, or at indentations. Correcting your work may be done by using "INSERT", hitting "RETURN" to insert a space between lines and paragraphs. Also when you try to indent or tab and ADAM moves the copy to the left when saved, or printed, call it back and place a period at the beginning of the line. Everything will then be OK, but do not try to remove those periods, or you will be back to square one!

Q. I am a handicapped person, and asked for help in obtaining computer equipment. The response was terrific! The ADAM from ADAMLAND is very nice, but I also received a Commodore 64 and a Sanyo 550-2. No monitors though. Is there a single monitor which will operate with all these?

A. Glad you liked the ADAM, Gene. Yes there is a monitor such as you need. It is the TEKNIKA MJ22, and it will accept composite video, separated video and RGBI and RGBA. It is the only monitor I know of which is truly a Universal monitor. We dug deep, and you will be getting one soon. If you need more equipment, we will let our general members know, and I am certain they will open their hearts to you.

Q. I want to buy a hard disk, possibly one of yours as soon as they are ready. However, I do not understand how I can store my programs, some in ADAM BASIC, others in CP/M, PASCAL, can be formatted on the same disk.

A. A certain number of megabytes can be allotted to each system, by use of the utility programs supplied with ours or everyone's hard disk, just as your regular DOS initializes your usual floppy disk. A word of caution. Do not expect that all your software will load on a hard disk. Some software is copy-protected, and "sees" the hard disk as an attempt to copy, and fails to load.
