

TELECOMMUNICATIONS

MANY PEOPLE HAVE THE PROBLEM OF LARGE PHONE BILLS BECAUSE OF THE USE OF THEIR MODEMS. YOU CAN CUT DOWN ON THE COSTS BY "CAPTURING" INFO FROM ONLINE SERVICES. WHEN YOU CAPTURE YOU CAN STORE WHATEVER COMES OVER YOUR SCREEN TO DATA-PAK OR DISK WHICH IS MUCH FASTER THAN READING OR USING YOUR PRINTER.

CONSIDER ORDERING IT SOON...FOR \$9.00 IT IS WELL WORTH THE INVESTMENT!!!). WHEN SETTING UP TO CAPTURE AN ONLINE SERVICE ALL YOU HAVE TO DO IS CALL THE SERVICE OR BBS, WHEN YOU GET CONNECTED EITHER PAUSE THE SERVICE OR WAIT FOR A PROMPT. WHEN YOU HAVE THE SERVICE SET HIT YOUR WILDCARD KEY AND SELECT THE FILE OPTION. YOU WILL THEN BE ASKED FOR A FILE NAME, AT THIS POINT I USUALLY PICK A NAME THAT WILL IDENTIFY THE FILE FOR FUTURE REFERENCE FOR EXAMPLE: COBRA930, WHERE "COBRA" IS THE NAME OF THE SERVICE AND 930 IS THE DATE SEPTEMBER 30TH. AFTER SELECTING A FILE NAME YOU MUST HIT THE WILDCARD KEY ONCE AGAIN TO RETURN TO TERMINAL MODE. WHEN YOU ARE BACK ONLINE WITH THE SERVICE YOU CAN GO THRU ANYTHING ON THAT SERVICE YOU WANT SUCH AS NEWS, BULLETINS, MESSAGE BASES, MENUS, DOWNLOAD LISTS, ETC. AND EVERYTHING THAT COMES OVER YOUR SCREEN WILL BE SENT TO DP OR DISK. WHEN YOU ARE FINISHED DON'T FORGET TO HIT YOUR UNDO KEY TO CLOSE THE FILE.

NOW WITH THE FILE ON DP OR DISK YOU CAN GO OVER THE INFO AT YOUR LEISURE WITH SMARTWRITER. THIS ALSO ALLOWS YOU TO PRINT OUT VALUABLE INFORMATION AND MENUS. YOU WILL FIND THAT USING THIS METHOD WILL SAVE YOU MANY \$\$\$\$\$ OVER A PERIOD OF TIME. ONE CAUTION WORTH MENTIONING....MANY SERVICES HAVE A TIMER WHICH WILL LOG OFF A CALLER IF THERE IS NO ACTIVITY WITHIN A SPECIFIC PERIOD OF TIME, SO BE SURE TO SET UP YOUR FILE NAME A FAST AS YOU CAN AND GET BACK ONLINE TO AVOID GETTING CUT OFF.

MANY PEOPLE HAVE BEEN ASKING IF THEY CAN DOWNLOAD CP/M AND BINARY FILES WITH THE ADAMLINK II. THE ADAMLINK II SOFTWARE WILL ONLY TRANSFER "DATA" FILES SUCH AS TEXT FILES FROM SMARTWRITER OR BASIC PROGRAMS. YOU MUST HAVE ASCOM, MADAM7, OR A SIMILAR CP/M BASED TERMINAL PROGRAM TO DOWNLOAD CPM HEX OR COM FILES. YOU CAN OPTAIN MADAM7 FROM THE COBRA BBS IF YOU HAVE CP/M BY FIRST DOWNLOADING THE FILE MBOOT.DOC FROM OUR FILE LIST WITH ADAMLINK II AND FOLLOWING THE INSTRUCTIONS.

COBRA BBS

AS MANY OF YOU KNOW THE COBRA BBS HAS BEEN UNABLE TO ACCEPT UPLOADS FROM THE ADAMLINK II. THIS IS ABOUT TO CHANGE....THE COBRA BBS WILL BE GOING ONLINE IN NOVEMBER WITH A WHOLE NEW LOOK. THE COBRA WILL HAVE A NEW FORMAT AND WILL HAVE ASCII (ADAMLINK II FORMAT) AND XMODEM CAPABILITIES FOR UPLOADING AND DOWNLOADING. THE NEW COBRA WILL ALSO HAVE AN EXPANDED FILE LIST WHICH WILL INCLUDE MANY CP/M PROGRAMS. WE ARE ALSO CHANGING TO A HAYES MODEM TO ELIMINATE THE PROBLEMS SOME OF YOU HAVE HAD LOGGING ON TO OUR BBS.

IF YOU HAVE ANY SUGGESTIONS FOR THE NEW COBRA, PLEASE SEND THEM TO US HERE AT THE ADAM-X-CHANGE. WE WANT TO MAKE THE COBRA BBS ONE OF THE BEST ADAM BASED BBS'S IN THE COUNTRY.

NOTE WHEN LOGGING ON THE COBRA BBS YOU CAN NOW USE YOUR DEFAULT SETTINGS WITH ADAMLINK II. WHEN YOU LOG ON ANSWER YES WHEN ASKED IF YOU NEED LINEFEEDS AND YOU BE ALL SET TO USE THE COBRA.

THE END OF SUPPORT FROM WEST HARTFORD?

ALTHOUGH COLECO MAINTAINS THEY WILL CONTINUE TO SUPPORT THE ADAM, THEY ARE MAKING IT VERY DIFFICULT TO BELIEVE. I HAVE HAD SEVERAL REPORTS THAT SEEM TO INDICATE COLECO'S INCREASING SEPARATION FROM THE ADAM. IF YOU HAVE TRIED TO CALL THEIR HOTLINE, YOU HAVE PROBABLY FOUND IT ALMOST IMPOSSIBLE TO GET THROUGH. I HAVE CALLED ONLY TO HAVE IT TAKE AN HOUR TO GET AN ANSWER AND THEN I HAVE BEEN PUT ON HOLD FOR OVER 1 HOUR ON TWO SEPARATE OCCASIONS. MOST TIMES I JUST GET NO ANSWER, WHICH CAN BE VERY FRUSTRATING AND TIME CONSUMING. I ALSO HAVE HAD TWO REPORTS FROM MEMBERS THAT THEY HAD PURCHASED DEFECTIVE COLECO SOFTWARE. WHEN THEY TRIED TO GET IT REPLACED UNDER WARRANTY THEY WERE TOLD BY COLECO THAT WHEN THEY PURCHASED THE SOFTWARE THAT IT WAS ON A "AS IS" BASIS. COLECO TOLD THESE CUSTOMERS THAT THEY WOULD ONLY WARRANTY PHYSICAL DEFECTS AND IT WOULD HAVE COST ONE MEMBER \$35.00 FOR THEM TO REPLACE HIS BRAND NEW (AND NEVER RUN) SOFTWARE! WHAT THIS ALL MEANS IS THAT YOU SHOULD BE SURE THAT THE BUSINESS WHERE YOU PURCHASE YOUR SOFTWARE WILL REPLACE IT FOR YOU IF IT IS DEFECTIVE. I WOULD SUGGEST EXHAUSTING EVERY POSSIBLE AVENUE BEFORE PURCHASING ANYTHING DIRECTELY FROM COLECO.

ANOTHER COMPLAINT I HEAR IS ABOUT THE LENGTH OF TIME IT TAKES TO GET THINGS ORDERED FROM COLECO. MEMBERS HAVE TOLD ME THAT IT HAS TAKEN UP TO FIVE WEEKS TO RECEIVE THEIR ADAMLINK II SOFTWARE AS WELL AS OTHER SOFTWARE TITLES. THIS LENGTH OF TIME FOR DELIVERY FROM A LARGE CONCERN LIKE COLECO IS REDICULOUS (MAYBE THEY OUGHT TO USE AN ADAM FOR PROCESSING THEIR ORDERS). I HAVE FOUND THAT I CAN GET HARD TO FIND ITEMS FROM HONEYWELL IN NO MORE THAN A WEEK. CHECK YOUR CLOSEST HONEYWELL BEFORE ORDERING FROM COLECO.

SMARTBASIC CORNER

MANY PEOPLE ARE JUST SETTING STARTED WITH PROGRAMING AND I AM SURE YOU WOULD LIKE SOME SHORT CUTS. HERE ARE A FEW COMMANDS THAT MAY HELP YOU SAVE TIME AND MAKE YOUR PROGRAMING MORE ENJOYABLE.....CONTROL X; THIS COMMAND WILL ERASE A WHOLE LINE AS LONG AS YOU HAVE NOT ENTERED IT.....CONTROL S; THIS COMMAND WILL WILL PAUSE ANY SCREEN LISTING (HIT ANY KEY TO RESUME).....CONTROL L; THIS COMMAND WILL CLEAR THE WHOLE SCREEN. WHEN TYPING A "PRINT" YOU CAN SUBSTITUTE A "?" FOR EXAMPLE; 10 ? "HELLO".

: Excellent 3.75 "ADAMCALC" IS COLECO'S SPREADSHEET PROGRAM AND IT IS VERY 600D. AS WITH "SMARTLOGO" "ADAMCALC'S" MANUAL HAS A QUICK REFERENCE CARD, DESCRIPTION, DEFINITIONS, AND DEMONSTRATIONS OF ALL OF "ADAMCALC" MAKING IT EASY TO LEARN OR REFER TO. ONE NEAT THING ABOUT THE MANUAL IS THE COMPARISON OF "ADAMCALC'S" COMMANDS TO VISICALC'S. THERE IS A SET OF VERY USEFUL SPREADSHEETS, SUCH AS, A LOAN PAYMENT SCHEDULE, LOAN COST ANALYSIS, HOME BUDGET AND INVENTORY, IRA PLANNER, AND TWO MORE.

THERE IS A SECTION ON HOW TO BUILD A SPREADSHEET STEP BY STEP, AND A "LEARNING ADAMCALC STEP-BY-STEP" SECTION. THE REFERENCE GUIDE IS BROKEN DOWN INTO COMMANDS, FORMULAS, FUNCTIONS, AND ERROR MESSAGES MAKING ANYTHING UNEXPECTED EASY TO LOOK UP. ENOUGH OF THE MANUAL AND EXTRA'S IS THIS ADAMCALC A GOOD SPREAD SHEET? SURE IT IS! YOU CAN ENTER NUMBERS OR TEXT. ENTER MULTIPLE FORMULAS OR JUST USE THE BUILT IN CALCULATOR. YOU CAN SORT, COPY, AND DELETE FROM FILES. EVEN INSERT MORE THAN I WINDOW IF YOU LIKE. HECK YOU CAN CHANGE THE COLOR OF YOUR INFORMATION. YOU CAN PRINT \$, DECIMALS, OR WHOLE NUMBERS, AND WHEN YOU ARE FINISHED YOU CAN TURN YOUR SPREADSHEET INTO A SMARTWRITER FILE, EDIT IT, AND PRINT IT. ALL IN ALL ADAMCALC IS A VERY POMERFUL AND EASY (YOU EVEN CAN HAVE A HELP FUNCTION) SPREADSHEET. ADAMCALC IS AVAILABLE FROM COLECO'S DIRECT ACCESS. SEE BELOW.




DATA-DRIVES FOR \$9.95!

AN ADVERTISEMENT APPEARED IN THE OCTOBER 1985 ISSUE OF POPULAR SCIENCE THAT SHOCKED THE ADAM OWNERS WHO READ IT. AMERICAN DESIGN COMPONENTS OF NEW JERSEY HAS APPARENTLY PURCHASED SEVERAL THOUSAND FIRST GENERATION ADAM DATA-DRIVES FOR RESALE. I HAVE PERSONALLY PURCHASED 10 OF THESE DRIVES AND HAVE FOUND ALL BUT ONE TO BE IN NEW WORKING CONDITION. THE AD STATES THAT THESE DRIVES ARE NEW AND THEY WILL REPLACE ANY UNITS FOUND TO BE DEFECTIVE. THIS IS AN EXCELLENT CHANCE TO ADD THAT SECOND DRIVE OR JUST BUY ONE OR TWO FOR BACKUPS (REMEMBER, EVEN IF YOU HAVE DISK DRIVES SOME SOFTWARE WILL ONLY RUN FROM DRIVE #1).

AMERICAN DESIGN COMPONENTS IS LOCATED AT 62 JOSEPH STREET, MOONACHIE, N.J. 07074. YOU CAN ORDER BY PHONE BY CALLING 201-524-0809 (IN NJ 201-939-2710) HONDAY THRU SAT 9AM TO 5PM. AMERICAN DESIGN HAS A MINIMUM ORDER OF \$15.00 AND A SHIPPING AND HANDLING CHARGE OF \$3.00 PLUS 10% OF TOTAL ORDER.

WHEN YOU ARE READY TO INSTALL YOUR NEW DRIVES YOU MUST BE CAREFUL TO INSERT THE PLUG CONNECTORS PROPERLY. IF YOU HAVE THE CONNECTORS EVEN ONE PIN OFF, YOU COULD DAMAGE THE DRIVE, YOUR ADAM, AND EVEN A DISK DRIVE (IF CONNECTED). I FOUND THAT THE DRIVES I RECEIVED HAD SOME TAPE RESIDUE ON THE HEADS, (PROBABLY DUE TO TESTING) SO BEFORE USING I WOULD RECOMMEND CLEANING THE HEAD WITH A COTTON SWAB AND SOME RUBBING ALCOHOL. CLEANING THE HEADS ON YOUR DRIVES IN THIS MANOR SHOULD BE MADE INTO A REGULAR ROUTINE. KEEPING THE HEADS CLEAN MAY HELP TO ELININATE I/O ERRORS. I DO NOT RECOMMEND THE USE OF HEAD CLEANING TAPES OR KITS, YOU WILL FIND THAT IN MOST CASES THE ABOVE MENTIONED METHOD WILL WORK JUST FINE. THERE IS ONE OTHER DATA-DRIVE RELATED ITEM WORTH MENTIONING AT THIS TIME..... IF YOU ARE HAVING TROUBLE REMOVING TAPES FROM YOUR DRIVES, JUST REMOVE THE METAL CLIP FOUND ALONG THE UPPER EDGE OF THE TAPE ENCLOSURE. I HAVE NOTED TWO METHODS USED IN THE MOUNTING OF THESE CLIPS; EARLY DRIVES HAD THE CLIP MOUNTED JUST ABOVE THE MIRROR INSIDE THE FRONT OF THE DRIVE. YOU WILL FIND A SPRING HOUNTED THERE WITH A SCREW, REMOVE THE SCREW, SPRING AND CLIP. NOW, RE-MOUNT THE SPRING WITH THE SCREW, THIS COMPLETES THE OPERATION. WITH THE LATER DRIVES THE CLIP IS MOUNTED UNDER THE TOP PLATE WHICH INCLUDES THE DOOR LATCH. TO REMOVE THIS TYPE OF CLIP YOU MUST CAREFULLY REMOVE THE TOP PLATE BY LIFTING THE TWO LOCK BARS COMING FROM THE BACK OF THE COVER. WHILE HOLDING THESE BARS UP, GENTLY SLIDE THE TOP FORWARD UNTIL FREE. AFTER REMOVING THE CLIP, RE-MOUNT BY REVERSING THE THE ABOVE STEPS. SEE DIAGRAMS BELOW.
