Advertising in AUGment was starting to grow and the newsletter was the shopping ground for all ADAM owners who needed hardware, software and supplies.

We were just toddlers trying to grow up quickly so that we could satisfy your needs. It wasn't very long before we reached teenager status and, although we were still learning, we managed to increase our membership without the help of Coleco.

That year the cost of an annual membership was \$12.00 (US).

In order to present you with the latest information in an up-to-date manner, we have invested in additional hardware and software. Remember, now that Coleco is not producing any more ADAM products, we have been forced to buy additional drives and other peripherals so that we can continue without concern about our ADAMs losing their parts.

Whether you are using disk or data pack, CP/M or SmartBASIC, we intend to support you for as long as you ask us to...and for as long as you continue your support.

Dear AUG,

I use ADAM mainly for accounting, primarily using ADAMCalc for schedules. Following is a Title Listing of the schedules I use. Since there is no "Program" as in BASIC, I have no idea whether other users would be interested or not.

1. Daily Invoice Summary (Sales, Sales Tax, Cash Receipts & Running Receivables.)
2. Monthly Sales Taxes (Listing of three states, Total Receipts, Tax Amt., Resale and Exemptions Amounts.)
3. Profit and Loss Statement, Monthly
4. Balance Sheet Statement, Monthly
5. Comparative P and L and Balance Sheets (vertical columns for monthly comparisons.)
6. Cash Receipts & Sales Summary (Month End Summary with Acct. Numbers.)
7. Cost of Sales and Inventory, Month End Statement.
8. Accounts Payable Summary, Month End Statement.
9. Cash Disbursement Summary, Month End Statement by Acct. Numbers.
10. Travel Itinerary.
11. Loan Payment Schedule.
12. Receivable Aging, Current Amt., +30 days, +60 days & Total/Customer.
13. Receivable Aging, using Basic with Data Statements (Results the same, but ADAMCalc is less work.)

If you are are interested, I will provide a copy of the schedule and a print of the pertinent formula for the schedule.

All the above are individually tailored to my purpose, not "copied."

DearAUG,

After buying Packcopy V1.1 and Hacker's Guide to ADAM, I found that there were many commercial programs that would not run when copied from tape to disk. This is because of the disk's smaller storage capacity (160 Kbytes compared to the data pack's 255). Most programs don't actually take up that much room, but the program itself may be up in those high blocks. In Recipe Filer, for example, the actual program only takes up about 38 blocks, but those 38 blocks start at block 200. All of the low blocks contain the file for the recipes Coleco included with the DP.

After experimenting and looking at a lot of code, I got the Recipe Filer program to run perfectly from disk. To do it, I had to move the program blocks down to lower numbers (where the cookbook file had been). Then, I had to change the directory in block 1 to point to the new position of the program and to delete the two cookbook files, SHOPPGLST and COOKBOOKDB. Finally, I had to change the boot program in block 0 to point to the new position of the program.

If anyone would like to know how to convert the Recipe Filer data pack to disk, I would be happy to send the instructions. Please remember to send a self-addressed, stamped envelope with your request.

DearAUG,

Here is a review of Fantasy Gamer, by Martin Consulting. I first saw Fantasy Gamer in an order catalog. The advertisers made it sound very nice. Boy, was I ever disappointed!

When it came in the mail, I rushed to my ADAM, put it into the data drive, and pulled Reset. To my amazement it stopped and typewriting mode appeared. Then I carefully read the instruction booklet. It noted it was written in BASIC, which I knew would be slow, and the graphics would not be too good. Fantasy Gamer includes two ready-to-run programs — Visitor and Bomb Squad. I first loaded Bomb Squad. At first, I thought something was wrong because it took about four minutes to load.

The game play was very poor. When you're at a room where graphics are displayed, and you make a mistake in your command, you must wait for it to draw the whole scene again. One reason I ordered this software was because the ad featured the program "Adventure Creator" -- which turned out not to be a program at all. It was only a framework program, in which you must go through the program listing, and program the entire thing yourself, which is very difficult. My instruction booklet was not clear at all — the reading, or the printing. It had many mistakes in it. In my opinion, this software was not worth over \$25. If you were thinking about buying this, think again. Spend the money on 2010: Text Adventure, or buy another data drive for about the same price.

The Reasons Why

Since the start of this publication, we have been receiving letters from members telling us that once in a while something goes wrong with our mailings. Here are some of the complaints:

- * Received first copies; then a copy skipped.
- * Received only an ID card but no newsletters.
- * Joined in July and didn't get mail until Sept.
- * Sent in renewal but label says LAST COPY.
- * Disks and binders take too long in delivery.
- * Already renewed but still get renewal letter.
- * Moved and didn't get any copies forwarded.
- * Newsletter sometimes early, sometimes late.

There are many reasons for these things happening. We will try to explain why.

First and foremost, we must tell you that there's no explaining the U.S. Postal System, but we'll try. We don't know why copies of the newsletter are skipped. The P.O. has no explanation. One of the reasons could be that you have a suite or apartment number. The regular carrier may know it and leave your copy in that box. If a new carrier is delivering the mail, he or she does not have to find out your apartment number. The newsletter is just returned to the P.O. and marked "NOT AT THIS ADDRESS." When the mail comes back to us, (which could be as long as ONE YEAR LATER), we DELETE your name and address as undeliverable. At that point you will not receive any more copies unless we hear from you.

When you received your ID card, you probably noticed that it was sent FIRST CLASS. This mail is forwarded to you even if the zip or part of your address is missing. That does not happen with BULK MAIL. The newsletter is mailed BULK and therefore treated as such. That's why it is important for you to check your label for errors and let us know about them QUICKLY. Depending on your local P.O., bulk mail is delivered to you anywhere from three days to three weeks from the time it is mailed. That is the reason the newsletter is sometimes early and sometimes late. Also, bulk mail is NOT FORWARDED when you move.

It is very important that you let us know when you are moving. Send us the old address (the label will be fine) as well as the new — the sooner the better. Make sure that your new address is correct and complete.

The reasons that disks, back issues and binders are long in delivery vary. Binders, back issues

and CompuServe Kits are sent BOOK RATE. That type of mail usually takes three to five weeks for delivery from the P.O. Disks are sent FIRST CLASS, but because of the quantity of requests we receive, we are sometimes out of stock and it can take as long as three to four weeks for you to get them.

Now let's talk about our system and what happens to a renewal or new membership when it arrives at our office.

Although we maintain our own database of members, all fulfillment is handled by an outside lettershop service. It is the same company that prints and mails our newsletter. When you become a member, your membership application with the information you provided is forwarded to the lettershop where it is processed. This could take up to two weeks. Sometimes your application arrives between newsletters and since this is a bi-monthly, it is possible that you may not receive your first issue for three months.

Renewals are handled in the same manner. If we receive your renewal early, you will not miss any issues. However, you may receive an issue with LAST COPY or RENEW printed on the label. You may also get a renewal letter. That is why we had "Disregard This Notice if Paid" printed at the bottom.

REMEMBER

If you are moving, be sure to send us your new address CORRECT and COMPLETE. Make sure your apartment or suite number is included. Send the label containing your OLD address and ID number along with the new address.

When you are renewing or extending your membership, include all the information printed on your label. If you miss an issue, let us know and we will correct your entry in our database and send you the missing issue.

If you haven't heard from us in a while, let us hear from you so that we can see if you were taken off the list because of a wrong P.O. attempt to deliver. PLEASE be patient when it comes to disks or other materials you may have ordered. We try to ship disks within two weeks, but since we have started offering disks at discounts and free with renewals, we are very often backlogged with orders.

Stage Fright

Mike McCauley did an excellent job in creating Stage Fright, a text adventure game. It is simple, exciting and adventurous. You can order your Stage Fright from Mike McCauley, 1442 Sorrel Street, Simi Valley, CA 93065, \$29.95 for either disk or data pack.

You must load SmartBASIC first. To play, you have to type RUN INTRO and then a menu will appear on the screen asking a few personal questions.

There are three rounds to the game, each with a new goal and new problems (as well as the old problems from the previous rounds.)

Round I leaves you trapped in the empty theater building and you must find the clues and tools to overcome a dozen traps and obstacles to get out.

Round II sends you back in to get rich, overcome another half dozen traps and find a second way out. The added twist is that it is impossible for you to take the treasure with you.

Round III is where life gets hard. You get sealed back in again, and now you must perform a rescue, retrieve a special object, and for your final bow, you must come up with the miracle of getting out of this place while all the exits remain sealed.

This game is unusual in that it is laid out on a fairly realistic map of a theater. It is a rectangular field, several layers deep. It will be the only way to tell where you are at times. Getting lost could mean your life.

There are many sequential events in the game, so something that didn't work at one time might work later, and something that was dangerous at one time might be safe later.

Most important, you have to get a feel for the thinking that went into the game. There are enough red herrings and blind alleys to keep things interesting, but there is an overall style to the clues, puzzles and solutions. You must see the pattern to be able to interpret the more subtle clues. The final challenge is presented with the message, "You figure it out if you claim to be so smart."

In Response...

to your most frequently asked questions...

...When you unpacked your disk drives, you probably found a cardboard drive protector in the drive. Whenever you move your ADAM disk drives, this cardboard should be used to keep the drive heads from undue jolts. If you can't find the original cardboards, substitute an old disk. (Save and mark one or two old disks for this purpose.)

...AT ALL TIMES all AUGies should have their ADAM on a surge protector (with four or six outlets) that has an off/on switch. In this way, your computer will be protected from power surges and spikes coming through the lines. When an electrical storm threatens, turn off your machine and pull the plug, even if you use a surge protector.

...If your screen freezes when you want to PRINT the file on the screen, SAVE the file on disk/dp first. Next, clear the screen and get the file again. Then it should print.

...You should ALWAYS make a BACKUP of all your text files and all programs that you have created yourself, as well as the programs you have purchased.

...In order to be able to PRINT just a section of a program or text file, you should HI-LITE only the text that you want printed. To do this, press Smartkey IV (HI-LITE), use the arrow key to underline everything that you want to be printed, press the PRINT command, and then press III (PRINT HI-LITE).

...In order to quiet your printer down, you might try placing it on a sheet of foam rubber. There are commercial enclosures, but they are expensive.

...If possible, write on a disk label before putting it on a disk. If you must change the information on a label, use a felt-tipped pen, NOT a ball point pen or a pencil. Sharp objects could damage the disk.

...If your keyboard sounds "tinny" or rattles as you type, using a cushioned pad underneath helps. Not only does it give the typing a more solid sound, it also reduces or eliminates the rattling. In addition, the actual key strokes seem to feel "softer."

M-Drawing

M-DRAWING is a mirror drawing in which what you draw with the joystick is duplicated on the other side. You can also use this program on Low-Resolution graphics.

Directions are in REM statements in the program. (This is a SmartBASIC program.)

Random Numbers

Over the past year or so, I have seen four articles in AUG about setting random seeds, one of which I wrote. Although the latest one in Vol. 2 No. 5 works, it is perhaps not the most efficient way of setting seeds.

Consider this approach:

That takes 17 fewer bytes than:

It is possible to CHEAT and get a non-random seed by pressing a key while the program is loading. This can be defeated with the following routine if a truly random number is essential:

Basic

The following program will allow you to make permanent changes to BASIC, changes which involve the default drive and the screen colors. The prompts will lead you through the changes you want to make. The only information you need is a list of colors and their values. Type in the program and save it. Then put a copy of BASIC (do not use your original copy) into one of the drives. The first prompt will ask you which drive your copy of BASIC is in. When you're ready type <RETURN> at the second prompt and the necessary information will be loaded from the BASIC disk or tape. Pressing the <ESC/WP> key during either of the first two prompts will end the program. When the main menu comes up you can make the desired changes. When you're done, press <I> for the save modes. You can save the changes to both the BASIC tape and current memory. The default drive, however, will not be saved to current memory.

Now we move to row 3. Enter the following cells in the 11 columns, leaving "RATE" column blank since this is not a mutual fund or cash:

The security is Beverley Bonds, currently selling for \$109.50. You paid \$5405.00 for your investment. The bond pays \$381.25 per year in interest. You own 50 \$100 blocks of the bonds. (This is \$5000 face value and it must be stated in the format of face value divided by \$100.)

Now we move to row 4, entering the following. All 11 columns are used since this is cash or a mutual fund:

Note that the rate column is left blank since these are not mutual funds or cash.

Walking through one stock line by line: We own 200 shares of DiGiorgio; current market price is \$23.275 per share; our total cost basis was \$296.50 for the entire 200 shares; the next two columns are formulas; the next (rate) column is blank; the stock pays \$128 in total dividends annually; the next two columns are formulas; the next column is a repeat of the name of our investment; the next column is the number of shares owned — 200.

To round out our portfolio, let's enter a mutual fund investment in row 8. It is similar to a stock entry except that the rate column is used and the div./int. column is a formula rather than a dollar amount:

To finish the program, we will skip 4 rows and enter the following in the 11 columns of row 13. This row will be quite important since it will give total portfolio data:

Memory Peeking

[The following was taken from "The Joy of Basic for the ADAM," by Gary West. Though the book has not yet been published, Gary was kind enough to send us a copy of the manuscript.]

Here is a program which will allow you to look into your computer's memory.

First, just of a word of interest. There are times when this program appears to stop and your keyboard appears to "freeze up." There seems to be nothing wrong with the machine. What has happened is that the computer has found a character that tells it to WAIT — and it can wait for a short time or it can wait for a long, long time.

In most cases, it is best to just slide the <RESET> switch (don't forget to take your data-pack out of the drive unit first) and to start over. You will have to load **SmartBASIC** again following the <RESET>.

For all the above reasons, you should immediately save this program after you have

keyed it in. In that way, you can simply reload it if you have to <RESET> (instead of having to rekey the whole thing).

Second, this program will allow you to see almost everything between byte address 00000 and byte address 65535. That is going to include all of **SmartBASIC** as well as several other things. There may be a point at which you want to stop the display so that you can take a closer look. Just press Ctrl-S and when you're ready to start again, you can press any key.

When you run this program, you're going to find all kinds of things. Most of those will look strange, but you will recognize some of what you see. Remember that you can use Ctrl-S to stop the display so that you can take a long look at some of the data. You might try the following addresses to see if you can find a personal message that was put in by the creator of **SmartBASIC**: 01056 to 01063. Then experiment a little.

547 Concentration (Games)

PICKEMUP: A version of pick-up-sticks where you try to be the one who picks up the last stick. On your move you can pick up any or all sticks in one pile, or pick up the same number from all non-zero piles. In BLACKBOX you try to determine the position of molecules in a black box. SALVO is a version of Battleship in which you take turns trying to sink the other's ship. After you have made your shot, A number will appear in the selected square indicating the approximate distance from your target. The direction is not known. Before you make your next shot, the computer may sit still or move one square horizontally or vertically. CONCENTRAT is a popular game in which you try to uncover two identical objects. You can make it hard or easy by selecting the number of different shapes in the grid. In ORBIT you have to achieve a stable orbit around planets of varying sizes. (Joystick is required.) MOON is a four phase simulation of an expedition to take pictures of the back side of the moon. SIMONSAYS: Choose the level of difficulty from 2 to 12 in order to select the number of repeatable digits. Each successful attempt will add one more digit to the sequence.

548 Golden Adventures (Games)

KUTENK, a text game: Collect all the treasures and arrive at the Pharaoh's chamber in the fewest turns, warning the PHARAOH'S evil spirits and curses not like your intrusions. BACKPACK, a text game: You are in a 50 mile cross-country backpack race, starting with a five day food supply and a one day water supply. Choose your daily hiking speed. You lose and have to radio for help if you go without water for two days. VAMPIRE, an adventure game, has a concealed goal, which you discover by exploring your surroundings. The computer will act as your eyes and hands. It will accept short phrases as commands and assumes that the first word is the object. The WUMPUS lives in a cave of 20 rooms, each with three tunnels going to other rooms. You have a choice of caves to play in. The hazards are: Bottomless pits in two rooms — if you go there you fail into the pit (and lose!); Superbats in two rooms — if you go there a bat grabs you and takes you to another room at random. The Wumpus is not bothered by hazards. He has suction feet and is too big for a bat to lift. Usually he is asleep. Only two things will wake him up: your entering his room or your shooting an arrow.

The object of GOLDENFLUTE (GOLDEN), an adventure game, is to return the golden flute to the Woodlands in the fewest moves. At all times, watch out for Dragons, Sirens and Goblins, Gargoyles and the dreaded hopeless pits. POKER is a card game. You start out with \$100 for betting. HORSERACE is a racing game with Daily Doubles and Pick Six. In TOWER you try to move all the disks from one tower to another without putting a larger disk on top of a smaller disk. As a LIGHTCYCLE, you take on the identity of the user-believer champion, Tron. Avoid the light traces and the walls, but try to force your opponent into either. LONDON is an adventure game set in the streets of London. You have a mission to complete in one day, from 9:00 AM to 5:30 PM. Unfortunately, you cannot recall what it is that you are supposed to be doing. You must work fast to discover the secret, but do not get distracted by unimportant events or you will be too late. WAREWOLF is an adventure game.

549 TimeOrganizer (Utilities)

INIT2 permits up to 73 files to be stored on a disk or data pack, instead of the usual limit of 35. It converts block 2 from a data block to a directory block. It will convert a blank formatted disk/dp. If the disk/dp is full, it will still convert, but the first file will be corrupted. If this is a "deleted" file with an A or H extension, then there's no problem. Otherwise, the first file should be copied before running INIT2. INIT2 cannot increase the number of blocks available. TIMEORGNER asks you the day, the time of the event, and notes. You can schedule an unlimited number of events. You'll have to experiment. It provides an instant printout. FONTINSTAL changes ADAM's text characters to an easier to read, better looking text. SCRNCOLOR is an easy way to access your screen's colors without constantly typing in the pokes. LOTTO is a good way of getting randomized numbers of any size.

Thanks for your response to my letter in the last issue of AUG. There were 174 letters and 94 telephone calls and all requests were complied with.

Some facts: In the Northeast area, the Zayres stores (chain) are selling the ADAM for \$199.95 and they are still getting shipments. A lot of people are asking about obtaining disk drives. They are available at Don Perlman, 620 Harmon Cove, Secaucus, NJ 07094. Price \$200.00. He also does disk drive repairs, CPU repairs and printer upgrade (including the new style head). He also has some ADAM Calc manuals for \$5.00 without binders. Available now from the same fellow is an F-PROM burner, which will allow you to copy Atari cartridges to ADAM disk or tapes. You must have the Atari expander to use this product. There is also a Coleco Test utility to check the speed of your tape drive with instruction on how to "fine tune" your drive to the correct speed. Other outfits to buy disk drives from are Adamlnd in Wyoming and Alpha 1 in New York.

For those of you who still have a chance to purchase CP/M 2.2, do so. A conservative estimate of programs available is about 1000. Even if you don't use CP/M at first (it takes a while to learn) the possibilities are unlimited.

Helpful Hints

I thought it would be a good idea to mention the importance of software to a computer system. Software allows the user to perform tasks quicker, easier, and more accurately. There are many different types of software. There are programs for word processing, money management, entertainment, and many other things. Below are a few software titles which can make your job a lot easier.

First, for spreadsheet programs, there is one which can prove to be very useful. AdamCALC, by Coleco, can help keep track of monthly payments or expenses.

As for word processors, ADAM, of course, has a built-in word processor, SmartWRITER, a very easy to use program which provides the user with many useful functions.

For those ADAM owners who like to write their own programs but are tired of SmartBASIC and want a change, there are a few programs that can provide you with a new place to work and experiment. First, if you don't want to stop programming in Basic but want to make it more interesting, Future Vision has just the program. Auto Aid is a SmartBASIC enhancement which is a great way to get more out of your SmartBASIC. Auto Aid offers benefits such as keyclicking, caps lock, Smartkey definition, sprite and sound capabilities, and another graphic mode. If you need a change from Basic programming, you can switch to SmartLOGO, by Coleco. SmartLOGO simplifies sound and graphics so that even an average programmer can create colorful graphics and sound effects without having to sit for hours attempting to learn the language. SmartLOGO even features tutorials for the younger programmer. If you have tired of SmartBASIC and are looking for more of a challenge, then you may be interested in CP/M 2.2, by Coleco. I myself have only experimented with CP/M but I found that there is a lot of software available for CP/M such as word processors, telecommunication programs, spreadsheets, games, and high-level programming languages like Cobol, Fortran, and Pascal.

I would be happy to hear from any AUGies who have ideas or programs they would like to share.

## CP/M Stuff

On your CP/M disk/dp is a program named SUBMIT.COM. If you were brave enough to run it to see what happens, you probably got the message "Error On Line 001 No 'SUB' File Present."

Before we create a SUB file, let's find out what the SUBMIT.COM program does.

SUBMIT allows you to "chain" together a list of commands that you would like to have your ADAM perform in sequence. The commands such as PIP, STAT, DIR, TYPE and the other CP/M stuff can be used. You can also ask SUBMIT to run a .COM file if you like.

Enough said...let's try it.

Type PIP and at the \* prompt type:

```
*TEST.SUB=CRT:
PIP B:=A:EXAMPLE.TXT
DIR B:
REN B:SAMPLE=EXAMPLE.TXT
THAT IS GREAT!
```

After typing in each of the lines do a Control-J (which is a line feed.)

When you have finished, press Control-Z and then <RETURN>.

Make sure that your CP/M disk/dp has SUBMIT.COM and EXAMPLE.TXT on it.

Place your CP/M disk/dp in drive A and "warm boot" (Control-C).

Place a formatted disk/dp in drive B. At the A> prompt type:

```
SUBMIT TEST.
```

Notice that the commands you have written in your TEST.SUB file were performed in order. Your disk/dp in drive B: now has EXAMPLE.TXT on it.

Can you think of other uses for SUBMIT? How about calling for a program, working on it and then saving it to disk/dp using SUBMIT? Try it. It really works well. Just remember that the file MUST have a .SUB extension.

If you create some good .SUB files, send them to CP/M Stuff and we'll let other AUGies know about them.
