

IN THIS MONTHS ARTICLE I WOULD LIKE TO EXPLORE THE SUBJECT OF ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE. ALTHOUGH I WILL NOT BE CREATING A FRANKENSTEIN, I WILL BE SHOWING YOU A PROGRAM WHICH SEEMS TO LEARN AND REMEMBER THINGS WHICH YOU TEACH IT. RATHER THAN DEVELOP THE PROGRAM IN PIECES I WILL EXPLAIN WHAT IT DOES AND HOW IT WORKS AND THEN PRESENT THE FINISHED PRODUCT.

A DIALOG WITH THE PROGRAM WOULD LOOK LIKE THIS:
ARE YOU THINKING OF AN ANIMAL?
AT THIS POINT YOU CAN TYPE LIST, SAVE, YES, OR NO.
LIST WILL TYPE OUT ALL THE ANIMALS THAT ADAM HAS
LEARNED. SAVE WILL SAVE ALL THE ANIMALS THAT ADAM
HAS LEARNED ON THE DISK. NO WILL END THE PROGRAM.
YES WILL CONTINUE THE PROGRAM. IF YOU ANSWER YES
ADAM WILL ASK YOU A SERIES OF QUESTIONS (FOR
EXAMPLE, DOES IT SWIM?) AND ACCORDING TO YOUR ANSWERS
IT WILL TRY AND DEDUCE THE ANIMAL OF WHICH YOU ARE
THINKING. IF IT CANNOT GUESS THE ANIMAL (BECAUSE IT
HAS NOT LEARNED IT YET) IT WILL ASK YOU FOR THE NAME
OF THE ANIMAL BY TYPING:
I GIVE UP, IT WAS A?

Now you type in the name of the animal (for example, GURILLA). ADAM will then ask you to type in a guestion which distinguishes the animal you thought of from the one ADAM thought it was. Your answer should be a question without the final question mark (for example, DOES IT HAVE FUR). Finally, ADAM will ask you what the answer would be for your animal (enter yes or NO). At this point ADAM has learned your animal (if you make a mistake at any point before this you can press the ESCAPE/WP key and type BEGIN to start over). This game is especially useful for KEEPING TEN YEAR OLD CHILDREN OCCUPIED FOR HOURS.

THE ROOT OF THE PROGRAM IS THE LIST CALLED ANIMALS.
THERE ARE TWO TYPES OF ENTRIES WHICH CAN BE
INSERTED INTO THIS LIST:

- 1) QUESTION ENTRIES: THIS ENTRY IS A 4 ITEM LIST (E.G., [Q [DOES IT SWIM] 2 3]) AND IS USED TO ASK THE USER QUESTIONS ABOUT THE ANIMALS. THE FIRSTENTRY IS A WHICH SIGNIFIES THIS AS A QUESTION ENTRY. THE SECOND ITEM IS THE QUESTION TO BE ASKED. THE THIRD ITEM IS THE ITEM NUMBER IN THE LIST TO GO TO IF THE QUESTION IS ANSWERED YES. THE FOURTH ITEM IF THE QUESTION IS ANSWERED NO.
- 2) ANSWER ENTRIES: THIS ENTRY IS USED WHEN ADAM HINKS IT FINALLY KNOWS THE ANIMAL. IT IS A TWO ELEMENT LIST (I.E., [A [BENGAL TIGER]]). THE FIRST ENTRY IS AN A WHICH SIGNIFIES THIS AS AN ANSWER ENTRY. THE SECOND ELEMENT IS THE NAME OF THE AMIMAL.

WE ONLY UPDATE THE LIST WHEN ADAM GUESSES AN ANIMAL INCORRECTLY (JUST LIKE YOU AND I, THE ONLY TIME ADAM LEARNS TO DO BETTER IS WHEN HE LOSES). WE MOVE THE INCORRECT GUESS TO THE END OF THE LIST, THE CORRECT ANSWER IS PUT AT THE END OF THE LIST, AND FINALLY THE NEW QUESTION IS PUT IN WHERE THE INCORRECT ANSWER WAS.

COMMUNICATIONS WORKSHOP

THERE HAVE BEEN A NUMBER OF QUESTIONS REGARDING UPLOADING AND DOWNLOADING FILES/PROGRAMS WITH THE ADAM.

LET'S REVIEW SOME BASICS: THE ADAMLINK MODEM IS NEEDED TO COMMUNICATE OVER PHONE LINES WITH ANOTHER COMPUTER (ONE THAT HAS FILES/PROGRAMS YOU MAY WANT TO CAPTURE). NOTE: UNDER CPH 2.2. THERE IS A FACILITY FOR USING OTHER THAN THE ADAM MODEM WITH THE EVE SP-1 RS 232 INTERFACE.

THERE ARE TWO SOFTWARE PROGRAMS THAT WORK WITH THE ADAMLINK MODEM TO COMMUNICATE WITH OTHER COMPUTERS. VERSION I COMES WITH THE MODEM. VERSION II, PROVIDES THE ABILITY TO UP/DOWNLOAD FILES AND PROGRAMS. VERSION II IS ONLY AVAILABLE FROM COLECO VIA A COUPON THAT COMES WITH THE ADAMLINK MODEM.

THE ADAMLINK VERSION II SOFTWARE ONLY HANDLES THE TRANSMISSION / RECEIPT OF "DATA" FILES SUCH AS BASIC PROGRAMS, SMARTWRITER FILES OR ANY FILES/PROGRAMS THAT DO NOT CONTAIN ANY SPECIAL CHARACTERS. THIS MEANS THAT ANY CPM 2.2 HEX OR COM FILES CAN NOT BE RECEIVED VIA THE ADAMLINK SOFTWARE. IN NEXT MONTH'S COMMUNICATIONS WORKSHOP, WE WILL DISCUSS THE COMMUNICATIONS SOFTWARE AVAILABLE TO HANDLE THESE TYPES OF FILES.

OKAY -- NOW PAST THE BASICS. LET'S WALK THROUGH AN EXAMPLE OF RETRIEVING A BASIC PROGRAM WITH THE NAME OF "GAME" FROM COMPUSERVE (CIS). THE FIRST THING YOU SHOULD DO IS READ THE ADAMLINK II MANUAL -- DO NOT SKIP THIS STEP OR YOU WILL BE IN TROUBLE! SIGN ON TO CIS AND GET INTO THE FORUM OR SECTION THAT HAS THE PROGRAM YOU WANT. LET'S ASSUME IT'S THE FAMILY COMPUTING FORUM. YOUR ENTRY FIELDS AND DISPLAY WOULD LOOK LIKE THIS:

UNDERLINED ITEMS ARE WHAT YOU ENTER -GQ_FAI1-200 FUNCTION: DL6

ONCE YOU ARE IN DL 6 (WHERE THE ADAM PROGRAMS/FILES ARE STORED IN FAM-200) YOU NEED TO FIND THE PROGRAM GAME. HERE ARE THE VALID COMMANDS IN DL 6:

SB - TYPE SCA - SCAN

- BROWSE THRU FILES

DIRECTORY OF FILES

ONCE YOU FIND GAME, YOU ARE GIVEN THE OPTION TO READ, DOWNLOAD, RETURN TO THE TOP DL 6 MENU OR GO TO THE NEXT FILE (BY HITTING RETURN). YOU WILL USE THE R (READ) OPTION TO DISPLAY THE CONTENTS OF THE FILE BUT NOT YET !! THE ADAMLINK II SOFTWARE DOES NOT UTILIZE ANY SPECIAL PROTOCOL TO RECEIVE FILES - IT RECEIVES FILES BY INTERCEPTING THE DATA THAT IS SENT OVER THE PHONE LINE AND DISPLAYED ON THE SCREEN. HENCE, YOU USE THE READ OPTION TO DISPLAY THE FILE. READ YOUR MANUAL WHICH WILL EXPLAIN HOW TO SET UP TO RECEIVE A FILE. WHAT I DO IS ENTER THE "R" BUT NOT HIT RETURN UNTIL AFTER I HAVE OPENED THE FILE AND PUT THE ADAM IN FILE RECEIVE MODE. ONCE THE FILE IS DONE DISPLAYING ON THE SCREEN. YOU HIT THE UNDO KEY TO CLOSE IT. THAT'S ALL THERE IS TO IT - GIVE IT A SHOT. SOME HINTS FOR UPLOADING A FILE TO DLG OR VIA EZPLEX. DON'T INCLUDE ANY UNDERLINES AND DON'T USE THE AUTOMATIC WORDWRAP MODE IN SMARTWRITER - YOU MUST ALWAYS PUT A CARRIAGE RETURN AT THE END OF EACH LINE AND ONLY LET YOUR LINES BE 50 CHARACTERS LONG.

CPH 2.2 WORKSHOP

CLINIC

CPM 2.2 IS VERY HARD ON DDP'S DUE TO THE EXTENSIVE READING AND WRITING DONE TO LOAD AND COPY FILES. I WOULD RECOMMEND YOU USE YOUR BETTER DDP'S (THE COLECO BRAND) FOR CPM USE OR BETTER YET GET A DISK DRIVE IF YOU PLAN ON ANY HEAVY USE OF CPM. WHEN YOU LOAD CPM 2.2 THERE ARE A NUMBER OF "RESIDENT" FUNCTIONS THAT ARE ALWAYS PRESENT SINCE THEY PERMANENTLY RESIDE IN MEMORY UNTIL YOU RESET THE COMPUTER. THESE INCLUDE ALL THE ONES LISTED AT THE BOTTOM OF THE SCREEN AND INITIATED BY THE SMARTKEYS: DIR - GIVES YOU A LIST OF THE FILES ON THE DRIVE SPECIFIED. IF NO DRIVE IS SPECIFIED THE CURRENT DRIVES DIRECTORY IS GIVEN.

ERA - No. THIS IS NOT THE EQUAL RIGHTS AMMENDMENT. BUT STANDS FOR "ERASE". IT REQUIRES A FILE NAME. INCLUDING THE DRIVE AND EXTENSION - E.G. "ERA DISPLAY.DOC". IF YOU ACCIDENTLY ERASE A FILE THAT YOU DID NOT INTEND TO THEN THE UTILITY UNERA19 ON THE CPM PD VOLUME #1 WILL RECOVER IT IF YOU RUN IT IMMEDIATELY AFTER YOU ERA THE FILE.

REN - USED TO RENAME AN EXISTING FILE.

USER - ALLOWS YOU TO GIVE EACH FILE ON A DISK UP TO 15 DIFFERENT NUMBERS WHICH WILL GROUP THEM I.E. YOU MAY WANT TO PUT ALL YOUR DOC FILES INTO USER 1, ALL THE COM FILES INTO 2, ETC.

SAVE - FOR SAVING THE CONTENTS OF MEMORY TO A DRIVE. THIS IS USED IN ASSEMBLING LANGUAGE PROGRAMMING AND DEBUGGING.

TYPE - SIMILAR TO LIST IN BASIC - DISPLAYS THE CONTENTS OF A FILE ON THE SCREEN AND PRINTER IF DESIRED.

T DISCUSSED LAST MONTH SOME BASICS OF CPM 2.2 FILE HANDLING, ESPECIALLY RELATIVE TO MANIPULATING THE FILES ON THE PUBLIC DOMAIN DDP'S. LETS TALK MORE ABOUT THE PD LIBRARIES. AS MANY OF YOU KNOW, THERE ARE MANY DIFFERENT PROGRAMS ON THESE LIBRARY TAPES. ONCE YOU COPY THEM AS EXPLAINED LAST MONTH, THE FIRST THING YOU SHOULD DO IS TO PRINT OUT ALL FILES WITH AN EXTENSION OF "DOC" E.G. DISPLAY.DOC. THESE FILES ARE DOCUMENTATION FILES THAT YOU MUST READ BEFORE TRYING TO RUN PROGRAM THEY ARE DOCUMENTING. I SUGGEST YOU PRINT ALL THE DOC FILES OUT ON THE PRINTER FOR LATER REFERENCE. YOU DO THIS BY USING THE TYPE COMMAND AS EXPLAINED ABOVE AND HITTING THE "CONTROL AND P" KEYS AT THE SAME TIME BEFORE YOU HIT THE RETURN KEY - HER IS THE SEQUENCE YOU SHOULD USE: TYPE A:DISPLAY.DOC <HIT CONTROL AND P> <HIT RETURN>. I STRONGLY SUGGEST YOU PURCHASE THE BOOK CPM USERS GUIDE FROM THE BUYING SERVICE TO GET MORE INTO CPM IF YOU ARE A NOVICE. THIS COLUMN IS ONLY MEANT TO SUPPLEMENT SUCH PUBLICATIONS.

THE 80 COLUMN SCROLL BUILT INTO CPM 2.2 FOR THE ADAM IS BOTH A BLESSING AND CURSE IN MY OPINION. IT CERTAINLY IS NEEDED BECAUSE OF THE LIMITATION OF 30 COLUMNS IN CPM MODE. HOWEVER, IT CAN MAKE YOU GO CRAZY TRYING TO READ A FILE. YOU NEED TO USE THE CONTROL AND ARROW KEYS SIMULTANEOUSLY TO MOVE AROUND THE SCREEN TO READ 80 COLUMN DISPLAYS. IN LAST MONTHS COLUMN I SUPPLIED A PROGRAM THAT WOULD AUTOMATICALLY "CUT" THE DISPLAY AT 30 CHARACTERS. I FIND THIS A PREFERABLE ALTERNATIVE TO THE 80 COLUMN SCROLL. HOWEVER, THIS ELIMINATION OF THE 80 COLUMN SCROLL WON'T WORK WITH SOME PROGRAMS LIKE WORDSTAR AND THE NEVADA BASIC. THESE PROGRAMS HAVE TO HAVE THE FULL 30 COLUMNS TO WORK PROPERLY.

NIAD CP/M PUBLIC DOMAIN LIBRARY BY C. KOLANDER

DO TO CONFUSION AS TO WHAT THE DIFFERNT FILES ARE AND WHAT THEY DO THAT ARE IN THE VARIOUS PD LIBRARIES. THIS COLUMN WILL GIVE A BRIEF EXPLANATION OF EACH. WE WILL TRY TO COVER ONE DISK EACH MONTH. MOST OF THE PROGRAMS HAVE VERY GOOD "DOC" FILES WITH THEM, AND WE WILL ONLY GIVE AN IDEA OF WHAT THEY DO. OTHERS HAVE NONE, AND WE WILL TRY TO COVER THEM MORE THOROUGHLY. NOTE: PLEASE READ THE CPM CLINIC COLUMN IN THE AUGUST NEWSLETTER FOR SOME BASICS ON HOW TO WORK WITH THESE PD LIBRARIES. ALSO, IF YOU DON'T UNDERSTAND THE BASICS OF CPM, READ YOUR MANUAL AND GET THE CPM USERS GUIDE BOOK.

VOLUMN 2 BASEBALL.COM - THIS IS A TEXT VERSION OF BASEBALL. VERY GOOD GAME.

SPLIT.COM - THIS PROGRAM TAKES VERY LONG ASCII FILES AND SPLITS THEM INTO SMALLER ONES. VERY HELPFUL WHEN YOU HAVE A FILE THAT YOU WANT TO EDIT AND IT IS LARGER THEN THE BUFFER. TO USE SIMPLY TYPE SPLIT FILENAME. TYPE, IT WILL THEN SPLIT IT INTO SMALL CHUNKS(10K) THAT WILL HAVE AN EXTENSION OF .001 ETC.

MDM740,M7LIB,M7FNK AND M7ADAM-1 - THESE ARE THE BASIC FILES TO SET A MODEM 7 SYSTEM UP ON YOUR ADAM. YOU HAVE TO ASSEMBLE M7ADAM-1, THEN USE DDT TO INSTALL IT INTO MDM740. THIS GIVES YOU A WORKING VERSION OF MODEM7, THIS VERSION DOES NOT HAVE DIALING. M7LIB ALLOWS YOU TO CHANGE THE PHONE NUMBERS IN THE MDM740 LIBRARY. M7FNK ALLOWS YOU TO CHANGE THE FUNCTION KEYS.

LU310, LU300 AND LRUN20 - THESE PROGRAMS ALLOW YOU TO SETUP OR USE FILES WITH THE EXTENION .LBR. LIBRARY FILES ARE USEFUL FOR SAVING BOTH FILE SPACE AND DIRECTORY SPACE. THE DOC FILE IS VERY EXTENSIVE.

IOMAP.COM - THIS PROGRAM DOES WHAT THE NAME IMPLIES. IT PRINTS A INPUT/OUTPUT MAP FOR YOU.

COMMON.COM - THIS PROGRAM IS FROM THE BOOK "CP/M REVEALED" BY JACK DENNON (HAYDEN BOOKS). IT WAS PUT IN THE LIBRARY TO SAVE EVERYONE SOME TYPING. THE PROGRAM ALLOWS YOU TO USE PROGRAMS "COMMONLY" AT ALL USER LEVELS. THERE IS SOME INFO ON IT'S USE IN THE READ. ME FILE, BUT IF YOU REALLY WANT TO KNOW MORE YOU SHOULD GET THE BOOK.

THIS WILL THEN PREVENT THEM FROM SHOWING UP OVER AND OVER IN YOUR CATALOG. THE NEXT THING TO DO IS TO PUT A DISK NAME ON EACH OF YOUR DISKS YOU ARE GOING TO CATALOG. TO DO THIS, JUST PLACE THE DISK IN THE DRIVE AND TYPE SAVE O -DISKNAME.NUMBER (THE "-" HAS TO BE THE FIRST CHARACTER OF THE FILE NAME IN ORDER FOR FMAP TO READ IT). THEN TO CATALOG SIMPLY HAVE YOUR CATALOG DISK IN A, AND THE DISK YOU WISH TO

CATALOG IN B, AND TYPE A:> FMAP B: F <= (OTHER EXT. MAY BE USED AS FOLLOWS - B PRODUCES A BIT MAP OF DISK, Q IS QUIET MODE NO LIST, *.FILETYPE ONLY CATALOGS THE FILETYPE NAMES). THEN YOU WILL HAVE A FILE ON YOUR DISK CALLED NAMES.SUB, TYPE UCAT, WHICH WILL INSERT THIS FILE INTO YOUR MAST.CAT AND THEN ERASE IT, YOU SHOULD THEN ERASE MAST.BAK AS THIS WILL BE CREATED EACH TIME YOU RUN UCAT. YOU KNOW HAVE A MASTER CATALOG. TO GET A HARD COPY SIMPLY USE CATPAGE. FIND.COM - THIS USED TO DO A CHARCTER STRING SEARCH OF ONE OR MORE FILES, WILL SEARCH ANY ASCII STRING. JUST TYPE FIND FILENAME STRING, " IN STRING WILL MATCH A TAB.

NOTE: VOLUMN 7 IS GOING TO CHANGE A LOT FROM THE LISTING SHOWN IN NIAD. MOST OF THE FILES ARE REPEATED FROM PREVIOUS DISKS, SO THEY ARE GOING TO BE DELETED. LOOK FOR A NEW LISTING ON THIS DISK NEXT MONTH.

WE HAVE BEEN DOING ALOT OF TALKING ABOUT "PEEKS" AND "POKES", WHICH MAY SOUND MYSTERIOUS AND ONLY FOR THE BASIC EXPERT. NOT SO! WE TALKED LAST MONTH ABOUT HOW THE ADAM'S 64K OF MEMORY IS USED BY SMARTBASIC THE MEMORY "SPOTS" BETWEEN MEMORY ADDRESSES 256 AND 27407 (DECIMAL) IS OCCUPIED BY SMARTBASIC ITSELF. MEMORY BETWEEN 27407 AND 53632 IS RESERVED FOR THE BASIC PROGRAM YOU ARE RUNNING (OR WRITING, IF YOU ARE DEVELOPING OR COPYING ONE FROM SCRATCH). THE ADAM'S OPERATING SYSTEM AND SMARTBASIC USE THE LEFTOVER MEMORY FOR SPECIAL PROCESSING AND STORING OF DATA THEY NEED.

BY USING THE SMARTBASIC COMMAND PEEK WE CAN SEE WHAT IS STORED IN SOME OF THESE LOCATIONS. AS AN EXAMPLE IF WE ENTER "PRINT PEEK(64885)" WE WILL GET THE VALUE OF THE LAST KEYBOARD KEY PRESSED. THIS CAN BE USED AS FASTER MECHANISM OF READING THE KEYBOARD THEN USING THE INPUT STATEMENT.

POKE IS ESSENTIALLY THE OPPOSITE OF PEEK - IT ALLOWS US TO PLACE A VALUE DIRECTLY INTO A MEMORY ADDRESS. THIS FUNCTION CAN BE USED FOR A WHOLE BUNCH OF THINGS SUCH AS CHANGING SCREEN/ TEXT COLORS, SCREEN MARGINS. ETC. PLEASE READ THE RECENT SMARTBASIC WORKSHOPS FOR SOME SPECIFIC USES.

So. PEEK AND POKE ARE NOT REALLY "HIGH-TECH", USE THEM TO BETTER UTILIZE YOUR ADAM.

THE FOLLOWING IS A COMBINATION OF TWO HI RES GRAPHICS ROUTINES THAT GIVE A REAL NICE SPACE SCENE WITH THE FAMOUS USS ENTERPRISE:

REVIEWS

NEVADA BASIC (FOR CPM) PART 2 BY L. MARSCHAND

IN PART I OF THIS REVIEW LAST MONTH, I GAVE YOU SOME OF THE FUNCTIONS OF THIS POWERFUL BASIC INTERPRETER. I AM SO GLAD THAT WE HAVE FOUND A REASONABLY PRICED CPM BASIC THAT HAS SO MANY FUNCTIONS.

THE ONLY LACK I FOUND IN NEVADA BASIC IS THE FACT THAT IT DOES NOT EDIT EACH LINE AS YOU INPUT IT LIKE SMARTBASIC DOES. HOWEVER, I DON'T THINK THIS IS A REAL BIG PROBLEM SINCE SUCH A POWERFULL FULL SCREEN EDITOR IS INCLUDED TO FACILITATE THE CORRECTION OF ERRORS. I WILL REVIEW SOME OF THE FUNCTIONS OF NEVADA:

- 1. FULL SCREEN EDITOR FULL CURSOR CONTROL OVER A SCREEN FULL OF DATA. SCROLLING OF BASIC PROGRAM UP AND DOWN, STRING SEARCH FUNCTION, LINE DELETE AND INSERT, CHARACTER DELETE, CHARACTER INSERT MODE. THIS EDITOR IS REALLY NICE AND A GREAT AID TO PROGRAM CREATION.
- 2. PRINT FORMATTING ABILITY TO FORMAT THE PRINT GOING TO THE TERMINAL SUCH AS MONETARY (I WISH SMARTBASIC DID THIS) OR ANY FORMAT YOU WANT.
- 3. AUTO LINE NUMBERING FOR PROGRAM CREATION.
- 4. PROTECTED SAVE YOU CAN SAVE A BASIC PROGRAM FOR EXECUTION ONLY, YOU CAN NOT LIST, EDIT, PRINT OR SAVE TT!
- 5. CHAINING TO OTHER PROGRAMS WITH THE ABILITY TO REMEMBER VARIABLE ASSIGNMENTS IN THE CHAINED PROGRAM.
 6. PROGRAM TRACE OPTION ABILITY TO LIST THE LINE NUMBERS OF EACH STATEMENT AS THE PROGRAM IS EXECUTING
- 7. CALL/ LOAD ABILITY TO CALL MACHINE LANGUAGE PROGRAMS AND EXECUTE THEM FROM THE BASIC PROGRAM.
 8. CURSOR CONTROL ABILITY TO POSITION THE CURSOR ANYWHERE ON THE SCREEN
- 9. EXIT ABILITY TO EXIT A FOR...NEXT LOOP ON A CERTAIN CONDITION.
- 10. Matrix operations These are special mathematical functions on 2 dimensional arrays.

THERE ARE SO MANY, I COULD GO ON AND ON. THERE IS NO WAY WE COULD TEST ALL OF THESE FUNCTIONS, BUT SINCE NEVADA BASIC HAS BEEN AROUND FOR AWHILE I HAVE TO ASSUME IT IS RELATIVELY BUG FREE.

MOST OF THE WORK WE DID WAS TO CONFIGURE IT TO WORK WITH THE ADAM KEYBOARD.

THIS IS A WELCOME ADDITION TO THE ADAM CPM PROGRAMMER.

FINALLY, THE WORLD OF INFOCOM GAMES HAS BEEN OPENED UP TO ADAMITES. YES, YOU HEARD ME, THE WORLD'S BEST ALL TEXT ADVENTURE GAMES CAN NOW BE RUN ON YOUR ADAM COMPUTER (IF YOU HAVE CP/M). ELLIAM ASSOCIATES HAS THE RIGHTS TO TRANSFER ALL INFOCOM CP/M GAMES FROM THE 8" DISK FORMAT TO ADAM FORMATTED DISKS. THE BEST PART IS THEY CHARGE THE SAME PRICE FOR THIS SERVICE AS IF YOU HAD BOUGHT THE GAME ORIGINALLY IN THE ADAM FORMAT (IT EVEN COMES IN THE ORIGINAL PACKAGING.

I CALLED ELLIAM ASSOCIATES ON A FRIDAY EVENING AND BY THE NEXT TUESDAY UPS HAD DELIVERED MY COPY OF "DEADLINE", INFOCOM'S INTERACTIVE MURDER MYSTERY. IF YOU'VE NEVER PLAYED ANY INTERACTIVE FICTION THE BEST WAY I CAN DESCRIBE IT TO YOU IS TO SAY THAT IT IS LIKE BEING IN A MOVIE IN WHICH YOU GET TO MAKE ALL THE DESCISIONS. YOU ARE A POLICE INSPECTOR AND HAVE

TWELVE HOURS TO SOLVE A "POSSIBLE" MURDER. THERE ARE PLENTY OF SUSPECTS INCLUDING A WIFE, A SON, A PERSONAL SECRATARY, EVEN A GARDNER (SURRY, THERE IS NO BUTLER). WHAT MAKES THIS GAME INTERESTING IS ITS OPEN ENDEDNESS. THINGS HAPPEN THROUGHOUT THE DAY EVEN IF YOU ARE NOT THERE TO SEE THEM. FOR INSTANCE, ONE OF THE SUSPECTS MIGHT DECIDE TO MAKE AN IMPORTANT PHONE CALL. IF YOU DON'T REALIZE IT AND PICK UP THE EXTENSION YOU MIGHT NEVER EVEN KNOW SHE MADE A CALL. ANOTHER GOOD EXAMPLE IS THE READING OF THE MURDERED HAN'S WILL. THIS TAKES PLACE AT ABOUT NOON (I SAY "ABOUT" NOON BECAUSE SOMETIMES THE OTHERS DON'T ALWAYS SHOW UP ON TIME AND THE READING IS DELAYED). IF YOU DON'T KEEP YOUR EYE ON THE TIME YOU MAY NOT MAKE IT TO THE LIVING ROOM IN TIME TO HEAR IT BEING READ. YOU WIL THEN HAVE TO QUESTION SOMEONE WHO WAS THERE TO FIND OUT WHAT HAPPENED.

LF YOU ARE A MYSTERY FAN THIS GAME IS A MUST (IT COSTS \$47.00). AFTER YOU ARE DONE YOU CAN GET "WITNESS" A 1930'S MURDER MYSTERY IN WHICH YOU ARE THE PRIME SUSPECT (\$39.00). BE WARNED THOUGH: INFOCOM GAMES ARE NOT EASY, BUT THEY ARE SATISFYING.

REEDY LIBRARY BY L. MARSCHAND

THIS SET OF SMARTBASIC PROGRAMS WAS DEVELOPED BY REEDY SOFTWARE OF ALTO, MICHIGAN. IT CONTAINS 8 PROGRAMS/ROUTINES WITH A NICE 12 PAGE INSTRUCTION BOOKLET. I WILL REVIEW EACH ONE:

- 1. MICHIGANA A TEXT ADVENTURE GAME WHERE YOU AS THE HERO, MICHIGANA JONES HAVE TO SEARCH AN OLD HOUSE TO FIND THE GOLDEN IDOL WITHOUT LOSING A LIFE AND BEFORE YOUR STRENGTH REACHES ZERO. THE HOUSE HAS 4 LEVELS AND 50 ROOMS WHICH YOU SHOULD MAP OUT AS YOU GO. GLUES MUST BE FOUND THAT WILL LEAD YOU TO THE IDOL. TWO WORD COMMANDS ARE USED TO DIRECT YOUR EFFORT. THE GAME IS INTERESTING AND CHALLENGING- IT IS 24 BLOCKS LONG, WHICH INDICATES IT AMOUNT OF WORK THAT WENT INTO IT. IF YOU LIKE ADVENTURE GAMES, THIS IS A GOOD ONE FOR YOU.
- 2. ADAMADDING A MATH DRILLING EXERCISE THAT HAS 6 SKILL LEVELS FROM 1 DIGIT TO 4 DIGIT ANSWERS. THE PROGRAM USES COLOR VERY NICELY AND READS THE ANSWER WITHOUT REQUIRING RETURN TO BE PRESSED. YOU CAN SET THE NUMBER OF QUESTIONS ASKED IN EACH ROUND AND A SUMMARY OF YOUR SCORE IS DISPLAYED AT THE END OF THE ROUND. A GOOD DRILL FOR KIDS.
- 3. ADAMCODE A CODING/ ENCODING PROGRAM THAT ALLOWS MESSAGES TO BE CODED INTO NUMERICAL CODES. A DECODING ROUTINE IS ALSO PROVIDED. NIFTY FOR KIDS TO PLAY WITH.

- 4. DEC-TO-HEX PRINTS OUT A CHART OF DECIMAL AND HEXIDECIMAL EQUIVALENTS.
- 5. VIDEOPAINT A LOW RESOLUTION PICTURE CREATOR AND EDITOR. THIS IS ABOUT THE BEST LOW RESOLUTION DRAWING PROGRAM I HAVE SEEN. ENHANCED FUNCTIONS INCLUDE THE ABILITY TO "LIFT" THE BRUSH AND MOVE, READING THE DDP/DISK CATALOG WITHOUT LEAVING THE PROGRAM, ONLINE INSTRUCTIONS, ABILITY TO CHANGE ALL OF ONE COLOR TO ANOTHER. SAVE AND LOAD ROUTINES ARE INCLUDED WHICH STORE THE PICTURE IN A 39x39 DIMENSIONED ARRAY THAT TAKES ABOUT 4 BLOCKS ON DDP/DISK.
- 6. SUBMAKER THIS PROGRAM TAKES A PICTURE FILE THAT WAS SAVED TO DDP/ DISK WITH VIDEOPAINT AND CREATES A ROUTINE OF DATA STATEMENTS THAT CAN BE INCORPORATED INTO ANY PROGRAM. THIS IS A REAL NICE FACILITY THAT INTEGRATES YOUR PICTURES RIGHT INTO YOUR EXISTING PROGRAMS AS SUB-ROUTINES THAT CAN BE CALLED WHEN NEEDED. THE ONLY PROBLEM IS THAT THE SCREEN PICTURE IS SAVED IN A 39x39 ARRAY WHICH GENERATES ALOT OF DATA STATEMENTS!
- 7. SAVESUB AND LOADSUB ROUTINES THAT SAVE AND LOAD PICTURES FROM DDP/ DISK. THESE ROUTINES CAN ALSO BE INCLUDED IN YOUR PROGRAMS IF YOU WANT TO SAVE AND LOAD PICTURES DURING THE PROGRAM. LOADSUB IS AN ALTERNATIVE TO SUBMAKER ABOVE THAT CAN READ IN A PICTURE FROM DDP/ DISK RATHER THEN HAVE IT AS A PERMANENT PART OF YOUR PROGRAM VIA DATA STATEMENTS.
- 8. SAVEPICT AND LOADPICT TWO STANDALONE PROGRAMS THAT CAN SAVE A PICTURE ON THE SCREEN AND LOAD ONE IN FROM DDP/ DISK.
- 9. TEXTEDITOR TAKES WHATEVER TEXT YOU ENTER AND DRAWS IT IN BIG LETTERS WITH HIGH RESOLUTION HPLOTS. NICE PROGRAM FOR PUTTING BIG INSTRUCTIONS ON YOUR SCREENS.

OVERALL, I WAS IMPRESSED WITH THE QUALITY OF THESE PROGRAMS AND THE FACT THAT YOU GET ALOT OF VARIETY WITH YOUR PURCHASE. THE USE OF THE PICTURE ROUTINES CAN GREATLY ENHANCE YOUR PROGRAMS.

THIS BASIC PROGRAM IS USED TO PRODUCE YOUR CHOICE OF PIE, BAR, LINE OR STOP GRAPHS. THE BAR GRAPH (ONLY THIS ONE) CAN BE PRINTED ON THE PRINTER. THE GRAPHS ARE PRODUCED ON THE SCREEN IN HI-RES.

ONCE THE PROGRAM STARTS, YOU ARE PROMPTED THROUGH A SERIES OF QUESTIONS REGARDING THE TYPE OF GRAPH WANTED AND YOUR DATA VALUES. AFTER THE GRAPH IS PRESENTED, YOU CAN NOW CHOOSE TO USE THE SAME DATA WITH A DIFFERENT GRAPH OR RESTART WITH DIFFERENT DATA.

ALTHOUGH WHAT IS HERE IS FAIRLY WELL DONE, I REALLY DON'T KNOW IF THIS IS WORTH IT. FIRST, YOU CAN ONLY PRINT BAR CHARTS. ALSO, YOU CAN ONLY USE A MAXIMUM OF TEN DATA VALUES, WHICH MUST BE ENTERED IN VIA PROGRAM PROMPTS. IT DOES NOT HAVE THE CAPABILITIES TO READ THESE IN FROM AN EXTERNAL FILE. THE BAR, STEP AND LINE CHART DISPLAY THE GRAPH AND THEN DISPLAY THE ACTUAL DATA VALUES. FOR SOME STRANGE REASON, THE PIE CHART ONLY SHOWS THE GRAPH, BUT NOT THE ACTUAL VALUES.

THE DISPLAY OF THE GRAPHS IS CLEAR. THE PIE GRAPH IS A GREEN CIRCLE WITH SEGMENTS FOR EACH DATA VALUE TYPED IN. THE STEP, BAR AND LINE GRAPHS ALL USE A BLUE CHART WITH ORANGE FOR THE ACTUAL PLOTTING. YOU CAN CHANGE THE SCALE FACTOR ON THESE LAST THREE.

Overall, I don't recommend this. What is there is okay, but I just don't think it's worth the money for the limited use it has.

THE YORD PLUS BY C KOLANDER

THE WORD PLUS IS A SPELLING CHECKER FROM OASIS SYSTEMS UNDER THE CP/M 80 OPERATING SYSTEM. ALTHOUGH VERY EXPENSIVE (100.00+ DOLLARS) IT IS A SUPER PROFESSIONAL PROGRAM SET. IT CAN NOT ONLY CHECK YOUR SPELLING, BUT CAN ALSO FIND WORDS, COUNT THE AMOUNT OF WORDS, SOLVE AMAGRAMS AND MUCH MORE. IT WILL RUN/WORK WITH MANY OF THE POPULAR CP/M WORD PROCESSORS. THE DICTIONARY IS EXTENSIVE, WHICH BRINGS UP THE ONLY PROBLEM WITH THIS PROGRAM AND ADAM. BECAUSE THE DICTIONARY IS SO LARGE (133k), THE PROGRAM DOESN'T WORK ALL THAT WELL ON ADAM'S DISK DRIVES. ALL OF YOUR SETTINGS CAN THEN BE SAVED SO YOU DON'T HAVE TO GO THROUGH THE SET UP AGAIN. THE PROGRAM THEN RUNS SPELL.COM WHICH CHECKS YOUR FILE, TELLS YOU HOW MANY UNIQUE AND

MISSPELLED WORDS YOU HAVE AND THEN RUNS REVIEW.COM.
REVEIW ALLOWS YOU TO LOOK AT THE WORDS THE CHECKER
THINKS YOU MISPELLED ONE AT A TIME. FROM A MENU YOU
CAN CHOOSE TO LOOK UP THE WORD, CORRECT IT, SAVE IT
TO AN UPDATE DICT., OR HAVE THE WORD MARKED SO YOU CAN
CHECK IT LATER. ONE OF THE REALLY NICE THINGS REVIEW
ALLOWS YOU TO DO IS SEE IN WHAT CONTEXT YOU USED THE
WORD IN SO YOU CAN MAKE SURE THAT THE WORD IS
CORRECT. THE DISKS COME WITH ABOUT 14 DIFFERENT
PROGRAMS ON THEM. THE PROGRAMS RANGE FROM A FIND
PROGRAM THAT ALLOWS YOU TO LOOK UP WORDS BUY PATTERNS
(YOU DON'T HAVE TO KNOW ALL THE LETTERS, WHICH CAN BE

THIS WAS SENT TO US THE OTHER DAY BY A NEW THIRD PARTY SOFTWARE COMPANY. FROM WHAT I SEE HERE, I HOPE THEY CONTINUE. THEIR FIRST EFFORT IS AN EDUCATIONAL PACKAGE CONSISTING OF U.S. CAPITALS, WORLD CAPITALS (197), AND ELEMENTS OF CHEMISTRY (103). THE 3 QUIZES EACH CONSIST OF OPTION FOR 1 OR 2 PLAYERS. WITH 2 PEOPLE, YOU EACH USE A CONTROLLER AND RACE THE CLOCK TO ANSER THE MULTIPLE CHOICE QUESTIONS. POINTS ARE AWARDED BASED ON TIME, AND IF INCORRECT, YOU GET NEGATIVE POINTS FOR THE WRONG ANSWER. WITH 1 PERSON, YOU CAN TAKE THE QUIZ THIS WAY OR YOU CAN SELECT THE FILL IN THE BLANK OPTION. THIS EVEN HAS A HINT OPTION, WHERE THE FIRST AND LAST LETTER OF THE ANSWER IS SHOWN.

YOU HAVE THE OPTION OF SELECTING THE NUMBER OF QUESTIONS YOU WANT AND ALSO HAVE THE OPTION OF REVEIWING THE QUESTIONS/ANSWERS FOR STUDY ON THE SCREEN OR YOU CAN GET A HARDCOPY.

ALL IN ALL, YOU HAVE VARIOUS WAYS IN WHICH YOU CAN USE THE QUIZES FOR DRILL OR STUDY. THE CHEMISTRY DATABASE COVERS ATOMIC NUMBERS, ATOMIC WEIGHTS, AND SYMBOLS.

THEY HAVE WRITTEN THE PROGRAMS IN BASIC, BUT THEY ARE NOT READILY LISTABLE. THEY HAVE ISSUED A CHALLENGE TO THE HACKERS TO FIND THE ACCESS INTO THESE PROGRAMS. I HAVE BROKEN THE CODE AND AS THEY HAVE SAID, THEY HAVE USED SOME ENHANCED ROUTINES TO CHANGE BASIC. THE WAY THE PROGRAMS ARE STORED WAS ALSO INTERESTING, AS IT MAKES IT LOOK AS IF THEY ARE BINARY-MACHINE LANGUAGE PROGRAMS AND NOT BASIC.

EACH OF THE 3 OUIZES EVEN START OUT WITH EXCELLENT HI-RES SCREENS. YOU CAN EVEN CHANGE THE COLOR COMBINATIONS ON THE OUIZ SCREENS, MUCH LIKE YOU CAN IN ADAMCALC. THEY HAVE INCORPORATED A PAUSE CONTROL ON THE TIME TESTS, SO YOU CAN ANSWER THE PHONE OR WHATEVER. THEY HAVE A VERY WELL DOCUMENTED 15 PAGE MANUAL THAT ALSO COMES WITH THE PACKAGE. THEY EVEN GIVE STUDY-USE TIPS.

I AM IMPRESSED WITH THIS INITIAL EFFORT. THEY HAVE DONE A FINE JOB ON THE OUIZES AND THE OPTIONAL USAGES THEY HAVE PROVIDED. WHAT IMPRESSES ME MOST, IS THE EXCELLENT, PROFESSIONAL PROGRAMMING JOB THEY HAVE DONE. THEY HAVE TAKEN CARE TO ADD NICITIES IN THE PROGRAM THAT NORMAL HASN'T BEEN FOUND ON ADAM THIRD PARTY SOFTWARE. 
