We have been providing our members and ADAM owners with the best possible service within our capabilities since our inception, which dates back to January of 1985, and we plan to be around for many more years to come. We are ADAM owners and users just like yourself who enjoy using the system and staying in contact with all the friends we have made through it. Anyway, if we decided to close-up, I wouldn't get all those free software demo programs to review in the newsletter and I know I'm not rich enough to maintain this hobby!

All that aside, N.I.A.D. was never theoretically closed during the whole moving process as we were able to move everything over to my house in one trip after business ours on a Saturday. On Sunday, which we have always been closed on, I was able to get everything setup in my house and ready for business as usual on Monday, albeit in a new location. For the last two months I have been filling orders, writing a newsletter, reviewing software and books, putting together new public domain volumes, attended an ADAM convention, published an ADAM glossary and in general performed all the duties I have performed for over four years at our old store. So you see while some things change, others stay the same.

Another event that I can't believe has already passed us by is ADAMCON 04. You will find an entire write-up on the fourth annual ADAM convention within the pages of this newsletter written by your's truly. The convention was a whopping success with a grand total of 94 full delegates in attendance (not counting their family members and day pass delegates). Such well known ADAMites as Pat Herrington,

Ron Collins, Mark and Scott Gordon, Dean Roades, Bart Lynch, Rich Clee, Ron Mitchell, Chris Braymen, Guy Cousineau, Tony Morehen, etc., were able to attend the convention and make it one experience I will never forget (along with ADAMCON 01).

There were many new products unveiled during the days of the convention, but the ones that I found most impressive were developed by Mark Gordon of Micro Innovations. Mark has used all his skills and knowledge of computer electronics to bring about a new era in hardware design and quality that I doubt can ever be rivaled by anyone for the ADAM except himself.

With the availability of two different hard drive setups (the L/C and H/P which you will read about in the News & Updates section) that are 100% compatible with one another, some tough decisions will have to be made. The L/C Hard Drive Interface card plugs into Expansion Slot #1 and if you have an ADAMLink 300 Baud Modem in this slot already, you will have to remove it. In this instance you could purchase an M.I.B. 3 card that supplies the necessary serial port (along with other interface ports) for hook-up of an external modem, but this could become quite expensive. The H/P Hard Drive Interface card plugs into Expansion Slot #2 and also provides a parallel port and addressor function. In this instance all you would have to do is remove the parallel interface card you may already own and store it as a backup or if you have a second system, install it in there. If you want access to an external modem then all you would have to purchase is the new Dual Serial I/O Card that installs in Expansion Slot #1.

This is just scratching the surface of possible choices to be made when purchasing an Micro Innovation's interface card or hard drive and this is why we will be writing an article on hardware options in the not so distant future that we hope will make your choices much easier. If you can't wait to get the low-down on these hard drive units, then by all means give me a call during normal business hours and I will try to steer you in the right direction. If I am unavailable at the time then leave a message on my answering machine and I will call you back.

An updated listing of ADAM Users Groups, Repair / Service Centers and Bulletin Board Systems is also contained in the pages of this issue. Due yourself a favor and take the time to write some of these groups or call a BBS every now and then. There are some truly fine newsletters being published by these groups that I am sure many of you would find interesting and well worth the membership dues. Also, if you are part of an A.U.G. that is not listed in this article please let us know about it so that we can add it to our next listing.

Starting on page seven of this newsletter, you will find our updated catalog of products for the ADAM that we supply. - Description of the ADAMnet FLOPPY DISK DRIVES. Following are the new suggested retail prices that have gone into effect as of Aug. 1st for each of the respective drives: 5 1/4" 320K F.D.D. \$199.95, 3 1/2" 720K F.D.D. \$249.95 (special for N.I.A.D. members only \$229.95) and the 3 1/2" 1.44Mb F.D.D. \$299.95 (special for N.I.A.D. members only \$269.95). The sale prices for both of the 3 1/2" F.D.D. are in effect through Sept. 18th. When purchasing a 3 1/2" F.D.D. we recommend giving the 1.44Mb model heavy consideration due to the fact that it can read and write the 720K disk format and offers double the storage capacity for only forty dollars more.
- → M.I. DUAL SERIAL I/O CARD has been released by Mark Gordon of Micro Innovations. This new interface card plugs into Expansion Slot #1 and provides two RS-232 serial ports one set up for a CRT terminal, serial printer or X-10 Control Interface and the other set up for an external modem. The serial ports are not compatible with the EVE and OBS serial ports but included software allows access and ADAMLINK V (sold separate) now allows for the use of the M.I. serial ports. The M.I. Dual Serial I/O Card is now available for the price of only \$49.95. Serial cables are sold separate and cost \$14.95 each.

- ⇒ M.I. MULTI-PURPOSE INTERFACE 3 has been released by Mark Gordon of Micro Innovations. This enhancement to the very popular M.I.B. 2 card plugs into Expansion Slot #2 and provides one 9 or 24-pin compatible Parallel Port, two RS-232 Serial Ports, Addressor function for memory expanders larger than 64K and now a Boot Prom Socket. A number of different program eproms can be plugged into this socket such as ADAM's Desk Top, SmartWRITER Elite or Operating System software for Hard Drives. Also, the need to plug in an adaptor to the power connector on the right side of the memory console for each serial port to be used is no longer necessary as Micro Innovations has provided a voltage regulator on the M.I.B. 3 card. Included with the M.I.B. 3 is the latest version of T-DOS, two E.O.S. patches for using a dot matrix printer with SmartWRITER, SmartBASIC, etc. and a number of CP/M or TDOS compatible telecommunications programs (for E.O.S. use of an external modem, ADAMLINK V is now available for \$24.95). The Multi-Purpose Interface 3 is now available for the price of only \$74.95. Serial and Parallel cables are sold separate and cost \$14.95 each.
- ⇔ M.I. PowerMATE L/C HARD DISK DRIVES have been released by Mark Gordon of Micro Innovations. The L/C configurations come with either a 20 or 40Mb IDE Hard Disk Drive that transfers data at 70ms, a Hard Drive Interface only card that plugs into Expansion Slot #1, a hard drive cable, power transformer, operating system software and public domain software preloaded. The case for this unit (and the H/P version) is slightly larger than the original Coleco disk drives. Suggested retail prices for the L/C Hard Disk Drives are as follows: 20Mb version is \$299.95 and 40Mb version is \$399.95. Introductory prices for N.I.A.D. members only through September 18th are as follows: \$279.95 for the 20Mb version and \$369.95 for the 40Mb version.
- ⇔ M.I. PowerMATE H/P HARD DISK DRIVES have been released by Mark Gordon of Micro Innovations. The H/P configurations come with either a 20 or 40Mb IDE Hard Disk Drive that transfers data at 28ms and has a built-in 8K cache, a Hard Disk Interface that plugs into Expansion Slot #2 and supplies a Boot Prom Socket, 9 or 24-pin Parallel Port and Addressor function, a hard drive cable, power transformer, operating system software and public domain software preloaded. Suggested retail prices for the H/P Hard Disk Drives are as follows: 20Mb version is \$349.95 and 40Mb version is \$499.95. Introductory prices for N.I.A.D. members only through September 18th are as follows: \$319.95 for the 20Mb version and \$469.95 for the 40Mb version.
- Property in the projects will in all likelihood be released before Christmas. Another projects will in all likelihood be released before Christmas. Another project being worked on by Scott Gordon is a fantastic adventure / role playing game called Dragon Master. Scott hopes to have this completed before Christmas also so that he can start work on some other game projects he has in mind. Watch for further details in upcoming issues of the N.I.A.D. Newsletter.

INSIGHTS ON ADAMCON 04

Mentor, Ohio - July 23-27, 1992 by Jim Notini

Another ADAM Convention has once again come and gone and as with the previous three the fourth convention has brought about a whole new- outlook for the ADAM. What once seemed to be a bleak and very short future to many has made a complete one hundred and eighty degree turn around for the better.

ADAMCON 04 started for me on the morning of July 23rd. I had decided to drive to the convention due to the close proximity of Cleveland to Chicago. After picking up my girlfriend, Michelle, we hit the highway for a six hour tour of the Great Midwest. Little did I know that it would take longer to get out of Illinois than to drive through Indiana due to what seemed to be endless road construction. Thankfully the Indiana and Ohio tollways had only small pockets of road construction so I was able to make up all the time lost in Illinois by driving at a speed that I will not mention here.

MENTOR, OHIO AT LAST!

At 6:10pm I walked into the lobby of the Travelodge of Mentor right on time to register for the convention. The lobby was set up as the registration area which was manned by Herman Mason, George Koczwara, Sandra Schwering, and Patricia Williams amongst others. After receiving my information packet for the convention I was able to watch the ADAMCON Information Manager run it's course on Ron Collins souped up ADAM system. For those of you who haven't heard anything about this demo, by Chris Braymen and Ron Collins, it is simply breathtaking. The Info. Mgr. is like a directory which allowed delegates to view in graphic form the complete schedule of events for AC IV, a listing of which rooms the delegates were in advertising screens for ADAM Users Groups, Bulletin Boards, Vendors, Hardware and Software Developers and more. Menus are provided on-screen and selections are made via a joystick that makes using this program very easy. Best of all while all this is being displayed on screen, accompanying music is being played through a MIDI Interface setup or ADAM's own sound chip. It is a very professionally designed piece of software that uses a wide range of special effects for the screen displays such as scrolling, screen fade in and out, page folding, etc. to manipulate the graphic screens. I think it has been released into the Public Domain by Chris and Ron, but I will have to check with them first and let you know next month.

After being awe-struken by the ADAM Info. Mgr. for an hour or so the reception started and all the delegates gathered for a few drinks and to get acquainted with one another face to face instead of over the phone. Familiar names like Ron Collins, Pat Herrington, Guy Cousineau, Tony Morehen, Bruce Walters, Bart Lynch, Dean Roades, Alan Neeley, Rich Clee, etc., were but a few I had the pleasure to talk with before running out for a bite to eat and retiring to bed to rest up for the following days events.

FRIDAY, JULY 24th

The morning of July 24th started a little late for myself as I slept through my wake-up call. I, however, did make it down to the banquet hall in time to grab a cup of coffee and hear George Koczwara's Keynote speech. The speech by George was rather brief, but this was probably for the best as everyone was itching to start the hands on sessions.

There were nine, two hour sessions scheduled for the first day with three running simultaneously. The morning sessions held were: Introduction to TDOS by Guy Cousineau, Comparing SmartBASICs by Rich Drushel, and Graphics by Pat Herrington. Some tough choices had to be made throughout the convention by the delegates as to what session they would attend since no one can be in three different locations at the same time. I decided to attend Rich Drushel's session which detailed the differences between the many available versions of

SmartBASIC. Rich overwhelmed his audience any myself with his vast knowledge and expertise on the subject as well as his 17 page outline on the subject.

The noon sessions consisted of: Beginners Machine Language by Bruce Walters, ADAM Hardware for Beginners by Jerry Vrancks and Dean Roades, and Telecommunications by Bart Lynch. I attended Bruce Walters' session which covered how exactly to go about programming in machine language. This is a very difficult subject matter to discuss in this type of environment, but Bruce was able to shed a little light on the matter with the aid of a number of delegates from the audience.

The afternoon sessions consisted of: ADAM "Pet Peeves" by Ron Mitchell, SmartBASIC Utilities by Alan Neeley, and Music by Chris Braymen. I attended Chris Braymen's session on playing music on the ADAM system. Chris, very expertly, worked his way through the many different stages of ADAM music programs until he reached the pinnacle that the ADAM is at right now concerning music, MIDI. At this point he gave the delegates a little taste of the abilities of his MIDI-MITE Interface and software so as not to ruin his follow up session on music the following day.

Following the last session Rich Clee took the opportunity to organize a meeting of the ADAM News Network Staff who made it to the convention in his room. Many subjects were discussed and future directions for A.N.N. were laid out. Look for A.N.N. to increase it's role in the ADAM community in the future and for N.I.A.D. to be working more closely with them on special projects, article contributions and public domain software contributions for their monthly disk distributions.

The last official meeting for the first day was for vendors only. I cannot go into a lot of detail on the subject matter, but I can say that the vendors and hardware / software producers will be working more closely together to avoid some of the problems that have arisen in the past as well as the software compatibility issue with hardware.

SATURDAY, JULY 25th

I missed breakfast once again, but made it down in time to decide not to attend any of the sessions being held in the morning. Instead I ran into a number of other delegates and discussed numerous subjects pertaining to the ADAM for nearly two hours.

The were six sessions scheduled for the second day of the convention with the morning sessions consisting of: Beginners TDOS by Guy Cousineau, Beginners Logo by Frances and Rich Clee, and Graphics by Pat Herrington.

The second group of morning session consisted of: Music by Chris Braymen, Easy ADAM Repairs by Howard Pines, and Telecommunications by Bart Lynch. I attended Chris Braymen's session on Music for the obvious reason that I attended his session from the day before. This time Chris quickly got into demonstrating the abilities of his MIDI-MITE hardware and software. In no time at all he was playing a beautiful song through the MIDI-MITE and then demonstrating how to use his SEQuel program. If only I could have taken a picture of the facial expressions of the audience for this session as the music filled the room. I am sure a number of people will be turned onto music due to Chris's superb demonstration.

After the sessions had ended the ADAM Store was opened for the vendors to display their products. As expected a large swarm of ADAMites quickly overran the display tables asking all types of questions and snatching up products that they had wanted to purchase

through mail-order, but decided to wait to purchase at ADAMCON. Vendors present at the store included AJM Software, ADAM Services, A.N.N., Oscar's Computers, Drushel Software, Bonafide Systems, Eyezod Graphics, S.M. Video, ADAMLink of Utah with the complete line of Micro Innovations products and your's truly, N.I.A.D. Other vendors did not set up a table at the store, but decided to setup a display area in their room so that the delegates could come by at anytime to see demos and purchase products.

The last session and official event of the day was held by Rich Clee and discussed the subject of beginning a users group. I did not attend this session since I previously promised my girlfriend that I would spend the rest of the day with her and visit one of Cleveland's hot spots, The Flats. It was the perfect opportunity for me to let the events of the past two days settle in and take a breather before the last day.

SUNDAY, July 26th

The last day of the convention started innocently enough with me missing breakfast once again. The itinerary for the day included six more sessions.

The morning sessions included: Intermediate TDOS by Guy Cousineau, Software for Hardware by Tony Morehen, and Graphics by Pat Herrington. I once again failed to make it to any of these sessions as I was caught up in a hot and heavy discussion with a number of the other delegates concerning the ADAM.

The afternoon session consisted of: Automating ADAM in TDOS by Bob Blair, E.O.S. Word Processing by Joe Alford and Dean Roades, and Telecommunications by Bart Lynch. I attended the session by Bob Blair in which he discussed many short cuts to speed up the operation of TDOS. In the audience were Guy Cousineau and Tony Morehen, the developers of TDOS, to make things more nerve wrenching for Bob. But as it turned out, Bob's presentation was terrific and both Guy and Tony were able to lend helping hands on different subject matter.

After the sessions had adjourned, the ADAM Store was once again open for a couple hours as well as Howard Pines' Repair Center (Howard was available the entire convention for repairs of ADAM equipment). Following the store was scheduled free time which I used to catch up on some sleep before the banquet was held.

The banquet started a little latter than scheduled since everyone was still relaxing and having a few cocktails. After enjoying a fabulous dinner of prime rib the final festivities began. George Koczwara took the podium and went over some facts on ADAMCON IV and then announced six new inductees to the ADAM Gallery of Honour. The six new inductees (five active and one inactive) were: Ron Collins of Orphanware, CL Digital, N.O.A.H. and now the B.A.S.I.C. Following the inductions, a special raffle was held for two quilts that were donated by Linda Walters and Sandra Schwering door prizes were raffled off and then the door prizes were raffled. Those who contributed door prizes included: ADAMLink of Utah, Norman Castro, Maine ADAM Library, 463 ADAM, CompuServe, V.I.S.A., Elliam Associates, ADAMzap, Kosowsky's ADAM Repair, S.M. Video, HLM / GMK, Disks To Go, M.T.A.G., Tony Patterson, Gary Hoosier, R & R Software, Eyezod Graphics, Oscars Computers, Hexace Software, Bonafide Systems, and N.I.A.D. amongst others. There were a number of peculiar situations as Bruce Walters won his own Hexace Software and Howard Pines won two free repairs from Kosowsky's ADAM Repair, but the prizes were redrawn so that someone else could win them. I was lucky enough to win Alan Neeley's ADAM Home Automation Package and this saved Alan from having to send me the review

package that we had discussed the day before.

Then it happened! After going nearly four days wondering if anyone was going to step forward and volunteer to run the fifth ADAMCON convention, it was announced that the ADAMCON banner had been passed onto Alan Neeley of ADAMLink of Utah. The previous night plans for Alan to undertake this mammoth responsibility had been finalized with the current co-chairmen Herman Mason and George Koczwara, therefore assuring the continuation of this tremendous yearly event. Also announced was the fact that someone has already come forward to host the sixth convention in two years. It's a long way off, but fortunately we know there is a taker for that one also. I wish Alan all the good fortune in the world and know that many west coast Americans and Canadians will be delighted by this news.

ADAMCON 04 was officially closed at this time by George and Herman who then announced that Mark Gordon had setup a system with his new hard drive and was going to be running a demo for all interested.

NEW PRODUCTS UNVEILED

Conventions are always the perfect place for hardware and software developers to unveil their latest masterpieces, even more so when you are developing products for an orphaned computer system. In most instances, only a lucky few will be able to see a demo of the product, the majority will have to read about it in newsletter reviews. Not so at ADAMCON.

This year news of new products to be shown for the first time was very scarce, two A.N.N. publications was about all I knew about beforehand. So it was a pleasant surprise when a number of developers introduced some very impressive products that they had just finished in time for the convention.

Heading the list was Mark Gordon of Micro Innovations with his Dual Serial I/O Card, Multi-Purpose Interface 3 and the new line of PowerMATE Hard Disk Drives. His son, Scott, was also in attendance and demonstrated a fantasy / role playing game he was drawing near to completing that should give some of the Nintendo and Sega games a run for their money (watch for details in upcoming issues). Other products officially released included: The E.O.S. Programmer's Guide by Guy Cousineau and A.N.N.; ADAMLink V by Rich Drushel, Tom Clary and HLM / GMK; ADAM - DOS by Bonafide Systems (which is public domain); Fontasy by Eyezod Graphics; A.N.N. ADAM Glossary by John Harris, A.N.N. and N.I.A.D.; The ADAM Programmer's Guide by The Maine ADAM Library; and vastly improved software for the ADAM Home Automation Package by ADAMLink of Utah and Chris Braymen. Numerous other vendors demonstrated products that they were working on and soon would be available. For full details and pricing on all these new products read the N.I.A.D. News & Updates section and see the full product description in this issue.

Also on display at ADAMCON 04 were some very impressive modifications of the ADAM Memory Console. Three that stick out in my mind are owned by Ron Collins, Rich Drushel and Ed Zelinksi. I plan to write to each of these gentlemen to see if they would be willing to write articles detailing their systems, the modifications that were made and how to go about performing the modifications as I am sure quite a number of you would be very interested in this information. One system that I didn't get a chance to see is owned by the Wick brothers, Neil and Dale. I had heard about this unit that is installed in an IBM compatible casing after ADAMCON 02, but unfortunately never got a chance to see it firsthand.

LOUNGE LIZARDS

Thinking back to ADAMCON 01 some of my favorite times at that convention in Orlando were not during the day, but rather late at night in the hotel lounge. I would have to say that the same can be said for this convention also. A number of other night owls, like myself, gathered each night after all the festivities just to unwind and discuss countless subjects. Some of these discussions ran into the wee hours of the night as we exhausted the lounge's supply of beer. To all the

lounge lizards out there (Mark, Scott, Tony, Guy, Chris, Russel, Don, Dean, Pat and Alan), the first round at ADAMCON 05 is on me.

IN CONCLUSION

I went to ADAMCON 04 not really knowing what to expect as far as turn out and the introduction of new products. There had been rumors going around that the total number of people planning to attend was around 70 to 80. But at the banquet we were informed that ADAMCON 04 had the best turn out of full delegates ever for an ADAMCON with 94. This figure did not even include family members of the delegates and also the day pass delegates. It was somewhat surprising to hear that this large of a turn out made it to the convention and is a very good sign for the future of the ADAM and ADAMCON.

There is no way for me to put in proper words what it feels like to attend one of these conventions and I'm afraid that if I tried the article would end up being the size of this newsletter. The best way to experience it is FIRST HAND so start making your plans to attend the next convention in Utah once the information starts to become available and watch for other articles on ADAMCON 04 in this newsletter to give you a few different perspectives.

My congratulations and thanks go out to George Koczwara, Herman Mason, the B.A.S.I.C. Group and the women of ADAMCON 04. You guys put on a tremendous convention and should be proud of yourself. 


